PUBLIC HEARING ORDER

The Vermont Transportation Board on August 17, 2016 beginning at 6:00 p.m. will conduct a public hearing on a petition to name Vermont Route 22A in its entirety within Vermont "The Desert Storm Veterans Memorial Highway." Vermont Route 22A runs through the towns of Fair Haven, Benson, Orwell, Shoreham, Bridport, Addison, Panton, Ferrisburgh and West Haven, as well as the City of Vergennes.

The public hearing will commence at 6 p.m. on August 17, 2016 at the Platt Memorial Library, which is located at 279 Main Street in Shoreham, VT. At the hearing, the Board will hear from the Petitioners and any member of the general public interested in the petition and potential naming.
