NOW COMES Orville Danyow, Sr., Philip and Doris O'Brien and Clarence and Sylvia Fisk, by and through their attorney, John R. Barrera, Esq., of the law firm of Conley & Foote, pursuant to the provisions of 19 VSA Sec. 421, and pursuant to Rule 75 of the Vermont Rules of Civil Procedure, and appeal from an Order of the Selectmen of Ferrisburg, Vermont, and complain and petition as follows:

- 1. That each is a resident of the Town of Ferrisburg, and owners of land adjacent to Town Highway No. 43, or a person interested in the discontinuance of the highway hereafter referred to.
- 2. The Selectmen of the Town of Ferrisburg have discontinued Town Highway No. 43 as a public highway and have designated same as a trail, as shown in an Order dated 21 November 1973, a copy of which is appended hereto and made a part hereof as Appendix A.
- 3. Said discontinuance was pursuant to a Notice of Proposed Discontinuance of Highway dated 19 September 1973, a copy of which is appended hereto and made a part hereof as Appendix B.

- 4. The discontinuance of Highway No. 43 was not made in accordance with the provisions of 19 VSA Sec. 531 in that there is no showing as to whether or not said highway was originally laid out by Commissioners of the County Court, or Town Commisioners, and hence the Selectmen may be without authority in acting upon said highway discontinuance.
- 5. The highway in question has not been surveyed in accordance with the requirements of 19 VSA Sec. 296, in that the monuments described in said Notice of Proposed Discontinuance of Highway and Order, do not exist.
- 6. There is no showing that the Selectmen have notified the State Board of Recreation as required by 19 VSA Sec. 535.
- 7. The Selectmen have disregarded substantial evidence that the convenience of the inhabitants of the Town of Ferrisburg and the public good requires that said highway should remain open and its status as a public highway not be discontinued.
- 8. The Order of discontinuance does not state findings of fact, or sufficience findings of fact to support the conclusion that said discontinuance is consistent with the welfare of the Town of Ferrisburg and its inhabitants.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs request that the Court:

- 1. Review the decision of the Selectmen within the provisions of Rule 75 of the Vermont Rules of Civil Procedure.
- 2. Or, in the alternative that the Court proceed to appoint Commissioners under 19 VSA Sections 422, 423 and 424.
- 3. Stay the Order of the Selectmen until further Order of this Court.

4. Grant such other relief; including damages to Plaintiffs, as is proper in the matter.
