We have received Granville's 2014 Certificate of Highway Mileage that the Town has submitted to us for review. The documentation for these changes was initially confusing, particularly for the down grading of Class 2 TH-1. To move the processing along, I have summarized the action I believe the Selectboard desires to make into three unrelated actions.

For TH-24

Current status is 0.34 miles of Class 3 town highway Proposed change to 0.34 miles of Class 4 town highway





Meeting was opened by holding a hearing to discuss and approve reclassification of 3 Town Highways.
