Gentlemen:

In accordance with Title 19, V.S.A., Section 15, as amended, all the traveled highways in your town were measured in 1981 by Mr. Marsceill, Road Commissioner, and Mr. Chabot, Road Inventory Chief of this office.

Your Class 3 mileage has increased by 0.100 mile due to a remeasurement change on Town Road 34.



SURVEY OF "CROSS ROAD" SO-CALLED, IN TOWN OF NEW HAVEN. THAT PORTION BETWEEN THE RIVER ROAD AND THE BEACH HILL ROAD WHICH IS TO BE RE-CLASSIFIED FROM TOWN ROAD TO TRAIL AND THAT PORTION WHICH IS TO BE THROWN UP.

Portion of Town Road which is to be classed as Trail:

BEGINNING at a point in the middle of said Cross Road about one-third mile westerly of junction with River Road, from whence the SE corner of the David Sumner house bears N 28 1/2 degrees W, 0.757 chains, and from which point Power Line pole #20-5 bears S 70 E, 0.757 chains,

thence along and nearly in the middle of said "Cross Road" (town road) the following courses:
