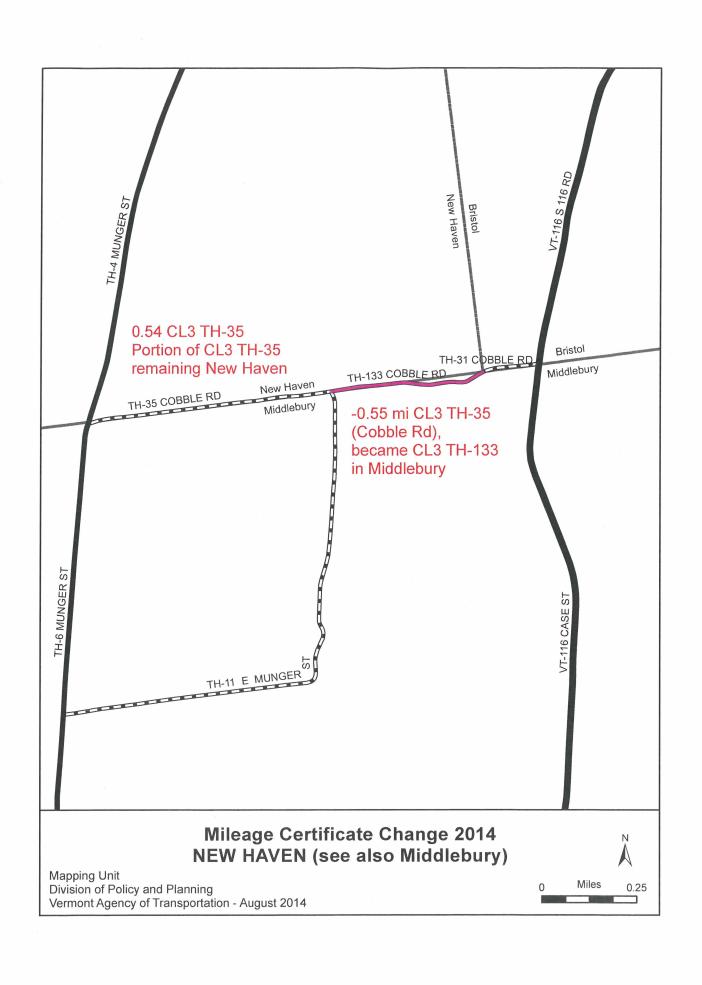

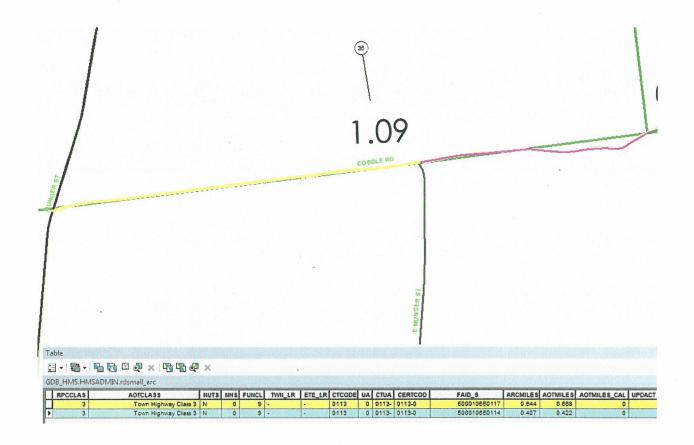

Dear Selectboard Chair,

This past week we received the 2014 Town Mileage Certificate information for the Town of Middlebury. Their information included reference to an agreement between the Town of Middlebury and the Town of New Haven concerning the maintenance of a 1.09 mile segment of Cobble Road. This road segment is currently assigned to New Haven and is designated as Town Highway 35. If I interpret the Middlebury submitted information correctly, New Haven and Middlebury have agreed to split the maintenance expense for this 1.09 mile segment. For State reporting purposes, the two Towns have agreed that they will split the mileage equally. Since the 2014 Mileage Certificate submitted by New Haven did not reflect this agreement with Middlebury, we will need to re-process your Certificate to show a 0.545 mileage reduction of Class 3 highway maintained by New Haven. Middlebury will show a 0.545 mileage increase. Before we can process the Middlebury Mileage Certificate, we will need for New Haven to confirm its acceptance of this agreement with Middlebury and to make the necessary correction to its 2014 Mileage Certificate. To facilitate making this correction, I am including a new copy of your certificate for 2014. Please obtain the necessary signatures and return it to me as soon as possible, using the included envelope.

The simple map that follows shows the 1.09 mile long portion of Cobble Road that VTrans understands is at the center of this agreement between New Haven and Middlebury. The yellow segment of Cobble Rd corresponds closely to the segment assigned to New Haven. Once it is clear to VTrans that this agreement is in place, we will divide the road into two segments that are each 0.545 miles long. The segment assigned to New Haven will commence at the intersection of Cobble Rd and Munger St and proceed east for 0.545 miles. The remaining 0.545 mile long segment is assigned to Middlebury. It ends at the intersection of the New Haven/Middlebury/Bristol town lines. It should be clear that VTrans is not a party to this agreement between New Haven and Middlebury. VTrans is simply working to help you (New Haven & Middlebury) maintain the transportation infrastructure as efficiently as possible. VTrans goal is to see Cobble Road maintained as a Class 3 town highway.

The yellow portion of Cobble Road closely corresponds to the segment assigned to New Haven. The red segment is assigned to Middlebury. The mileage maintenance assistance value will be equally split between the two towns
