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

(1) Public Concerns: None

- (2) Minutes: Bob MOVED, Marthe SECONDED, that the Minutes of October 28th be accepted. *Motion passed.*
- (3) Senior Housing Project: Jeremiah and Terry McKnight presented their concept for a Senior/fixed income housing complex which Jeremiah plans for a portion of his Village property adjacent to Greenwood Village. The proposal calls for construction of several one-story rental duplexes, with units available configured with 1, 2, or 3-bedroom. Units include parking for 2 vehicles, ADA accessibility. A 2-bedroom unit would be roughly 1200 sq ft. Terry, representing Addison County Community Trust, explained the ACCT's role in owning/managing the property and ensuring the perpetual affordability of the units. Lengthy discussion included Board's concerns regarding priority of Shoreham seniors in the selection process; the effect on the Grand List;the provision of various social/health services to the duplexes' residents (e.g. visiting health care providers); the Town's responsibilities regarding the grant monies should the project fail (block grant made to Town, Town loans to ACCT, when repayment begins, Town retains 50%, 50% repaid to State); amount of monthly rentals and financial assistance to ensure affordability. A set of Jeremiah's drawings left with the Board

(4) Roads: [Jason] The generator conduit has been installed, the wires need to be pulled.

- The reclassification of the stretch of Lake Street between Lapham Bay Road and the Bridport line, to Class 2, requires a letter of consent to be signed by December 3, a hearing, and a site visit. As Bridport has yet to sign their own letter of intent, both towns could sign a joint letter. Karen so MOVED, Marthe SECONDED, *motion passed*, Board signed joint Letter-of-Intent.

- Holmes Lane—Board signed State's *Application for Authority to Erect Street Name Sign* for Holmes Lane

- Town Office continues to receive complaints regarding the increased ferry traffic through the Village

- Winter prep continues on Town equipment, supplies

- Before moving on, the Selectboard presented Jason with a "Roads Scholar plaque, noting he is likely the only "roads" scholar in Shoreham. The plaque comes from Vermont Local Roads in

recognition of achievement of a certain level of accomplishment and education credits received from VLR workshops and educational opportunities. Board commended Jason on his high marks, and expressed pride and appreciation of his initiative in taking a number of ancillary courses purely for his pursuit of knowledge (ie: no credit benefits). Congratulations, Jason!

- (4) **Buildings:** [*Karen*] Amy noted that the Town of Randolph has offered up their temporary vault, which they had used for storage during construction of their new Town Office. Amy requested the Board's permission to follow up, confirm that the unit meets State requirements, and possibly put a "hold" on the unit. Our records storage needs are at a critical point, and unit will be useful when we begin whatever Town Office construction is decided upon. Board agreed she should proceed, and put a "hold" on the unit if it suits.
- (5) Emergency Management: (Robin) No report
- (6) Levi Morton Marker—Town has received an offer from someone who has volunteered to put in a cement pad and reinstall the Levi Morton marker. Board passed the offer along to the Historical Society.
- (7) Tour de Farms 2010—Scheduled for September19, 2010. Barb and Karen finalizing town policies proposal for such events, or for use of the Green by groups; they want to check with other towns hosting similar events to see what papers they require.
- (8) Selectboard Orders—reviewed and signed.
- (10) Other Business—
 - *VCRD*—School has been reserved for the December 1 meeting, 6 to 9 pm.
 - School Board Report—(Natasha) The School Board felt that they should have more of a presence at the Selectboard meetings, and will attempt to do so henceforth. Natasha reported that 90% of the elementary students received the N1H1 vaccination; no sign yet of H1N1 in the school; 70% receive hot lunches; the School Board is planning a community Thank You lunch in December, details to be forthcoming; work is beginning on the school budget.

Amy asked if both Boards want the issue of voting the school budget by Australian ballot to be on the Town Warning. Natasha will query the School Board and report back.
