Dear Mr. Saenger:

It has been brought to our attention that a portion of Class 3 Town Highway 57 (TH-57), known as Bates Road in the Town of Shoreham is not currently meeting the standard for a class 3 town highway and is signed as "Not Maintained During Winter." The standard for class 3 is defined in 19 V.S.A. § 302(3)(B) as:

"...The minimum standards for class 3 highways are a highway negotiable under normal conditions all seasons of the year by a standard manufactured pleasure car. This would include but not be limited to sufficient surface and base, adequate drainage, and sufficient width capable to provide winter maintenance..."

This portion of TH-57 is referenced as class 3 on the current 2014 General Highway Map of Shoreham, produced by the Agency of Transportation (VTrans) Mapping Section. This classification is based on information and changes supplied to VTrans by the Town on the Certificates of Highway Mileage. The portion of highway is currently listed as 0.25 miles of class 3 and is located off VT-74.

A copy of an excerpt of General Highway Map is enclosed with the highway highlighted.

As a result, this 0.25 mile section of class 3 of TH-57 has been deemed "Not Up To Standard" and will be moved into the class 4 classification on the 2015 Mileage Certificate, which will remove State Aid funding for this section of town highway. If TH-57 is still legally class 3, the class 3 classification will remain, but the section functions as a class 4 since it is not maintained during the winter.

This will take a bit of time to sort out on our end.


