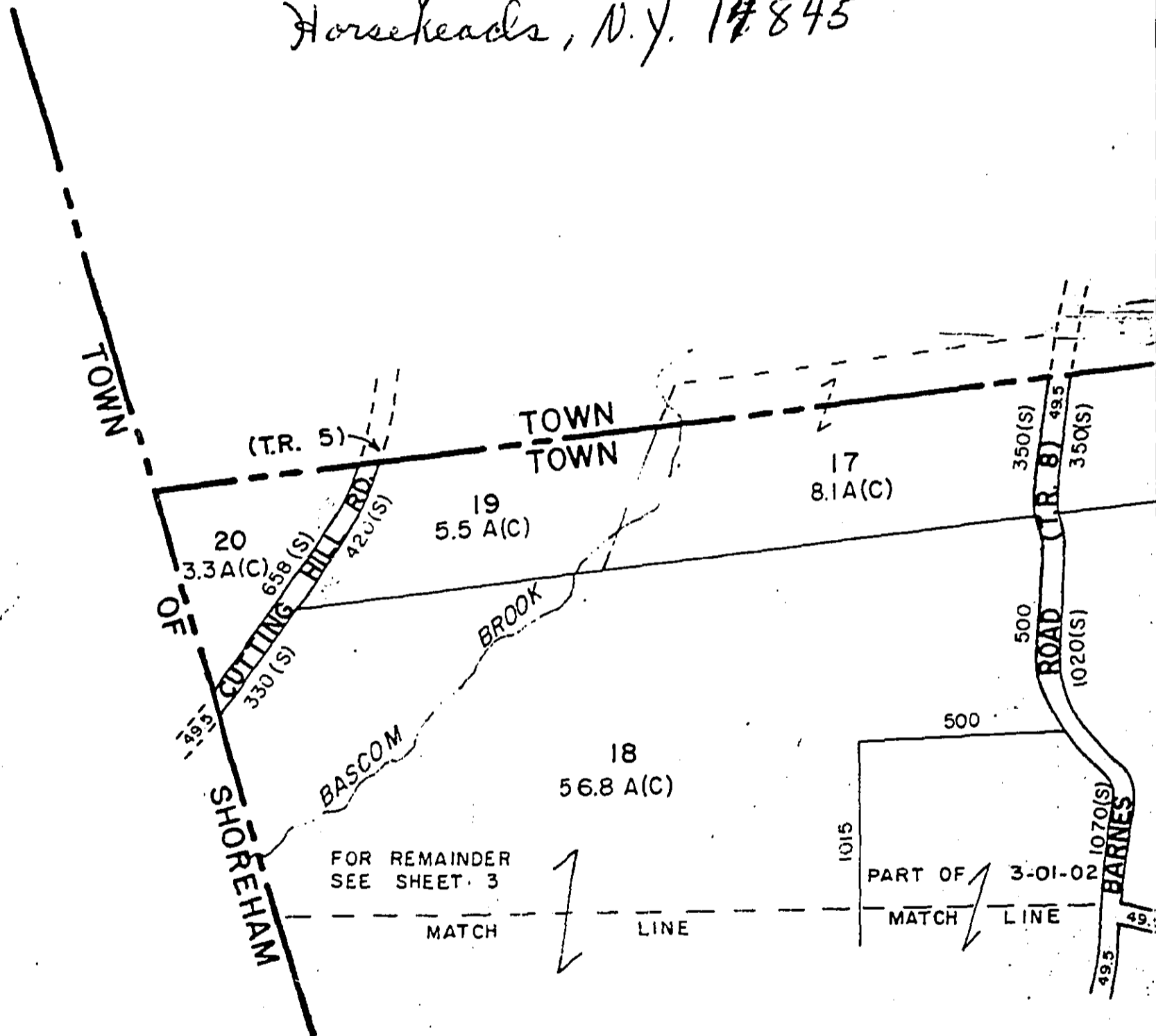


Your Annual Mileage Certificate has been overdue since February 15, 1982. This information is required so that the statewide totals by Town Highway class may be computed in March to derive the apportionment of funds to the towns for highways. Not reporting promptly not only delays this for your community, but all the communities in the State.

Title 19, V.S.A., Section 15, requires that every town, city, and village submit a Certificate of Highway Mileage to the Agency of Transportation no later than February 15 each year; and Title 19, Chapter 1, §19 states, "A town shall not be entitled to receive money from the State under this chapter in any year until it has complied with the provisions of this chapter".

In accordance with the Statutes, payment will be withheld pending receipt of your 1982 Certificate.

Gentlemen:

In accordance with Title 19, V.S.A., Section 15, as amended, all the traveled highways in your town were measured in 1981 by Mr. Quesnel, Chairman, and Mr. Chabot, Road Inventory Chief of this office.

The resulting change in your highway mileage is indicated on the enclosed map and explained as follows:

Your Class 3 mileage has increased by 0.070 mile due to the remeasurement on Town Road 6.

I am herewith forwarding the Certificate of Highway Mileage for your town for the year ending February 10, 1976. 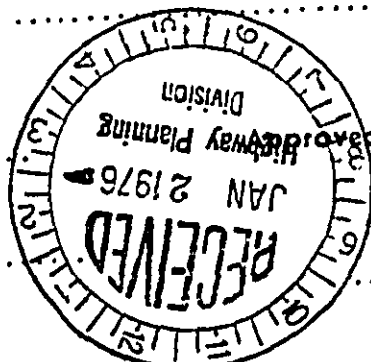

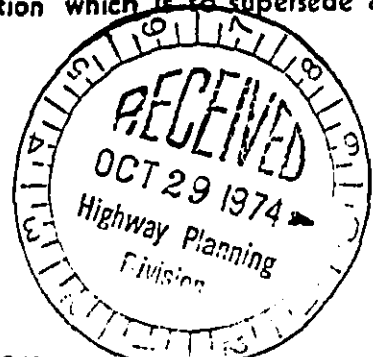

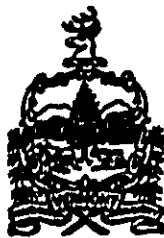
