Dear Mr. Keane:

It has recently been brought to our attention that we made an error in the 2013 Mileage Certificate for Bennington in the assignment of mileage of Class 1 TH-2 and VT-9 as part of project NH F019-1(5), now project AC NH 019-1(51).

We had misinterpreted the maintenance agreement for VT-9 on East Main Street, and inadvertently assigned the class 1 and state highway break farther to the east than it should be. The signage for the beginning of the state highway in the field is correct, but the assignment of mileage on the town highway map is not currently accurate.

Rather than wait another year to correct this error, we would like to include it as part of this year's Certificate. Enclosed is an updated 2017 Mileage Certificate with the error correction included.

We would like to request the Selectboard review the enclosed documentation and resubmit the signed Mileage Certificate for Bennington, which will correct this inaccuracy and allow for the class 1 and state highway break on VT-9 (East Main Street) to be properly mapped.

No. 123. An act relating to the state's transportation program.

(H.784)

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM

(a) The state's proposed fiscal year 2011 transportation program appended to the agency of transportation's proposed fiscal year 2011 budget, as amended by this act, is adopted to the extent federal, state, and local funds are available.

(b) As used in this act, unless otherwise indicated:

(1) the term "agency" means the agency of transportation;

(2) the term "secretary" means the secretary of transportation;

(3) the table heading "As Proposed" means the transportation program referenced in subsection (a) of this section; the table heading "As Amended" means the amendments as made by this act; the table heading "Change" means the difference obtained by subtracting the "As Proposed" figure from the "As. Amended" figure; and the term "change" or "changes" in the text refers to the project- and program-specific amendments, the aggregate sum of which equals the net "Change" in the applicable table heading;

(4) the term "ARRA funds" refers to federal funds allocated to the state by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009;

(5) the term "TIB funds" refers to monies deposited in the transportation infrastructure bond fund in accordance with 19 V.S.A. § 11f;

 Sec. 46. TOWN OF BENNINGTON; ADJUSTMENTS TO STATE
 HIGHWAY SYSTEM

(a) Under the authority of 19 V.S.A. § 15(2), the general assembly authorizes the secretary to enter into an agreement with the town of Bennington to relinquish to the town's jurisdiction approximately 1.07 miles of U.S. Route 7 (South Street) between mile marker 1.088 (near Carpenter Hill Road [TH #48]) and mile marker 2.156 (near the entrance to the Park Lawn Cemetery) to become a class 1 town highway.

(b) Under the authority of 19 V.S.A. § 15(2), the general assembly authorizes the secretary to enter into an agreement with the town of Bennington to accept as part of the state highway system approximately 1,300 feet of VT Route 9 (Main Street [TH #2]) between mile marker 5.655, near the location of a crosswalk to be constructed under the transportation project Bennington NH 019-1(51), and mile marker 5.901, which is the existing jurisdictional boundary between the state highway and the class 1 town highway. The agreement shall provide for the town of Bennington to be responsible for maintenance of sidewalks within the subject area.

VT LEG 258631.1

The relinquishment areas also include slope easements within and adjacent to the relinquishment areas and is subject to any utility rights-of-way and /or easements of record (if any).

The State retains ownership of the underlying fee.

2. Control of Junkyards. No junkyards as defined in 23 U.S.C.§ 136 and 24 V.S. A. § 2241, shall be established or maintained on the relinquishment area.

3. Control of Outdoor Advertising. Any outdoor advertising structures erected on the relinquishment area herein described shall comply with 23 U.S. C. § 131 and 10 V.S. A. Chapter 21.

4. Future Maintenance and Repairs. The Town will be responsible for all future maintenance and repairs in connection with the relinquishment agreement described above.

5. Encroachments. The Town will not permit any encroachments on the relinquishment area without written permission of the State.

6. Maintenance Agreement Zone. In certain areas, hereinafter referred to as "maintenance agreement zones", the operation and maintenance of a certain portion of East Main Street, Harvard Street, Hickory Hill, Linden Street, Chapel Road, and East Road should be under control of the Town.

7. Description of Maintenance Agreement Zones. The STATE turns over and the TOWN accepts the right and obligation for future maintenance and repairs on the sections of highway located within the maintenance agreement zones. The maintenance agreement zones are described as follows:

MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT ZONE(#1) (East Main Street)

Beginning at a point at station VT 1+200.00 on the Town Highway 2 (east Main Street) centerline of Highway Project Bennington North NH F019-1 (5);

thence 60.00 meters (196.85 feet), more or less, northeasterly along the Town Highway 2 (East Main Street) centerline to a point at station VT 1+260.00 on the Town Highway 2 (East Main Street) centerline of said Highway Project.

MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT ZONE #2: (Harvard Street)





19 V.S.A. § 305. Measurement and inspection

§ 305. Measurement and inspection

(a) After reasonable notice to the selectboard, a representative of the agency may measure and inspect the class 1, 2, and 3 town highways in each town to verify the accuracy of the records on file with the agency. Upon request, the selectboard or their designee shall be permitted to accompany the representative of the agency during the measurement and inspection. The agency shall notify the town when any highway, or portion of a highway, does not meet the standards for its assigned class. If the town fails, within one year, to restore the highway or portion of the highway to the accepted standard, or to reclassify, or to discontinue, or develop an acceptable schedule for restoring to the accepted standards, the agency for purposes of apportionment under section 306 of this title shall deduct the affected mileage from that assigned to the town for the particular class of the road in question.

(b) Annually, on or before February 10, the selectboard shall file with the town clerk a sworn statement of the description and measurements of all class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails then in existence, including any special designation such as a throughway or scenic highway. When class 1, 2, 3, or 4 town highways, trails, or unidentified corridors are accepted, discontinued, or reclassified, a copy of the proceedings shall be filed in the town clerk's office and a copy shall be forwarded to the agency.

(c) All class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails shall appear on the town highway maps by July 1, 2015.

(d) At least 45 days prior to first including a town highway or trail that is not clearly observable by physical evidence of its use as a highway or trail and that is legally established prior to February 10, 2006 in the sworn statement required under subsection (b) of this section, the legislative body of the municipality shall provide written notice and an opportunity to be heard at a duly warned meeting of the legislative body to persons owning lands through which a highway or trail passes or abuts.


(e) The agency shall not accept any change in mileage until the records required to be filed in the town clerk's office by this section are received by the agency. A request by a municipality to the agency for a change in mileage shall include a description of the affected highway or trail, a copy of any surveys of the affected highway or trail, minutes of meetings at which the legislative body took action with respect to the changes, and a current town highway map with the requested deletions and additions sketched on it. A survey shall not be required for class 4 town highways that are legally established prior to February 10, 2006. All records filed with the agency are subject to verification in accordance with subsection (a) of this section.


(f) The selectboard of any town who are aggrieved by a finding of the agency concerning the measurement, description, or classification of a town highway may appeal to the transportation board by filing a notice of appeal with the executive secretary of the transportation board.


(g) The agency shall provide each town with a map of all of the highways in that town together with the mileage of each class 1, 2, 3, and 4 highway, as well as each trail, and such other information as the agency deems appropriate.


