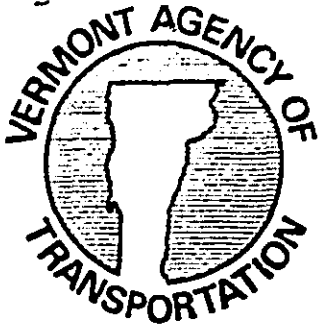

Gentlemen:
