Gentlemen:

In accordance with Title 19, V.S.A., Section 15, as amended, all the traveled highways in your town were measured in 1977 by Mr. Page, Selectman and Mr. Chabot of this office.

The resulting changes in highway mileage and any changes in classification are indicated on the enclosed map and explained on the attached breakdown sheet.

I am also forwarding, herewith, the Certificate of Highway Mileage for your town for the year ending February 10, 1978. The enclosed form explains the necessity for completing and returning the Certificate as well as the procedures to be followed in making changes to your Class 3 and Class 4 Town Highway System. Please read this form letter carefully before completing the Certificate.

In addition, the following mileage changes were brought to our attention during the past year:

Construction Project RS 0217(1) relocation decreased State Highway mileage in your town by 0.147 mile and a portion of Old Groton State Highway relinquished to the town adds 0.280 mile to Class 3. Class 4 Town Highway 16 was decreased by 0.100 mile by right-of-way for the construction project.

Mr. Page also stated that Town Highway 65 (Provisional) was an Old Town Highway. See Item H on the map. Before we can include this road in your system, however, it will be necessary for you to submit a Certificate signed by the entire Board of Selectmen that this road has been considered and maintained as a public highway for "X" number of years.


It was also noted that Class 4 Town Highway 25 was in error by 0.280 mile. The correct figure was 0.280 and was noted previously as 0.560.

Dear Mrs. Dennis:

We have enclosed a revised set of Mileage Certificates for your Town with corrections.

As explained in our previous letter and as shown on the attached maps, the following changes were noted:

In addition, Construction Project RS 0217(1) relinquished 0.280 mile of Old Groton State Highway to Class 3, Class 4 Town Highway 16 was decreased 0.100 mile by right-of-way taken and -0.147 mile of State Highway.
