
19 V.S.A. § 305. Measurement and inspection


§ 305. Measurement and inspection


- (a) After reasonable notice to the selectboard, a representative of the agency may measure and inspect the class 1, 2, and 3 town highways in each town to verify the accuracy of the records on file with the agency. Upon request, the selectboard or their designee shall be permitted to accompany the representative of the agency during the measurement and inspection. The agency shall notify the town when any highway, or portion of a highway, does not meet the standards for its assigned class. If the town fails, within one year, to restore the highway or portion of the highway to the accepted standard, or to reclassify, or to discontinue, or develop an acceptable schedule for restoring to the accepted standards, the agency for purposes of apportionment under section 306 of this title shall deduct the affected mileage from that assigned to the town for the particular class of the road in question.
- (b) Annually, on or before February 10, the selectboard shall file with the town clerk a sworn statement of the description and measurements of all class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails then in existence, including any special designation such as a throughway or scenic highway. When class 1, 2, 3, or 4 town highways, trails, or unidentified corridors are accepted, discontinued, or reclassified, a copy of the proceedings shall be filed in the town clerk's office and a copy shall be forwarded to the agency.
- (c) All class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails shall appear on the town highway maps by July 1, 2015.
- (d) At least 45 days prior to first including a town highway or trail that is not clearly observable by physical evidence of its use as a highway or trail and that is legally established prior to February 10, 2006 in the sworn statement required under subsection (b) of this section, the legislative body of the municipality shall provide written notice and an opportunity to be heard at a duly warned meeting of the legislative body to persons owning lands through which a highway or trail passes or abuts.
- (e) The agency shall not accept any change in mileage until the records required to be filed in the town clerk's office by this section are received by the agency. A request by a municipality to the agency for a change in mileage shall include a description of the affected highway or trail, a copy of any surveys of the affected highway or trail, minutes of meetings at which the legislative body took action with respect to the changes, and a current town highway map with the requested deletions and additions sketched on it. A survey shall not be required for class 4 town highways that are legally established prior to February 10, 2006. All records filed with the agency are subject to verification in accordance with subsection (a) of this section.
- (f) The selectboard of any town who are aggrieved by a finding of the agency concerning the measurement, description, or classification of a town highway may appeal to the transportation board by filing a notice of appeal with the executive secretary of the transportation board.
- (g) The agency shall provide each town with a map of all of the highways in that town together with the mileage of each class 1, 2, 3, and 4 highway, as well as each trail, and such other information as the agency deems appropriate.





Hi Heidi,

Were those private roads recently made public? My descriptions of the VTrans process of assigning Town Highway numbers isn't relevant to private roads. We don't keep records (or numbers) for private roads. E911 does, though!

Although we often include private roads in our GIS road centerline data (in an effort to stay in sync with E911), we don't keep records for private roads, and almost never show them on the Town Highway Maps. Similarly, we don't have Town Highway Numbers for private roads, as they are not "Town Highways". On some of the older archived maps you might see some private road numbers (e.g. P1, P2, etc), but I'm not sure why only a few were ever shown.

That doesn't mean that Highgate can't assign Road Numbers to private roads... or assign different numbers to public roads. It just means that you would need a system to ensure that you don't confuse your numbering system with our Town Highway numbers (as shown on the Town Highway Map). Don't forget that the map clarifies (defines) what we mean when we refer to a town highway class and number, and that it might not correspond to a single distinct road.

I get the sense you still have questions, but I can't tell exactly what they are based on the highlighted roads in your road issues list. Which column(s) in your road issues list corresponds to the VTrans "Town Highway" number? I'm confused by seeing two map number columns and a road number column, and don't know which is supposed to be ours.

I think Platt Rd Ext can either have its own new number, or be considered as part of TH-55 (which is more standard). I will double check if you're interested in giving it a new number.

Let me know if you want to speak by phone and I can give you a call. I'm working from home so I don't have to keep scraping ice off my car!

Hi Heidi,

Unfortunately the two maps of TH-30 didn't cover the same area as the 2003 survey I already had, so there weren't any clues about how it went from a straight road to having a hook at the end.

Your maps with the limits of CL3 highway drawn in are helpful! The next step to making those changes on the map and in our records is to find documentation showing that those locations were legally established (as opposed to being the result of informally changing the extent of maintenance).

Does Platt Rd officially end before the Right turn at the end (even if maintenance continues beyond that)? If you mean the southern end that is correct.

If it isn't easy for anyone to find documentation indicating that the CL3 portion of Waugh Farm Rd ends at the turnaround or parcel indicated, a temporary solution is to designate the CL3 section beyond the turnaround (highlighted in the image below) as Not Up To Standard (NUTS) so that it is included with the CL4 totals instead of the CL3 totals. Getting to the bottom of this might take some time as it probably involves various opinions in the past about the location of the town line between Swanton and Highgate. Having been there, the boundary isn't obvious in the field! Yes, thank you for your map. This option to downgrade to a class 4 sounds reasonable and I put the wording on the cert.

If you don't have the documentation, this should be added to the Certificate as follows:

0.23 mi CL3 TH-38 designated Not Up To Standard (NUTS) pursuant to 19 V.S.A. 305(a) (with 0.23 mi subtracted from class 3 total and 0.23 added to class 4 total). This is not a legal change of highway status, it is just a VTrans designation that allows us to clarify on the map that it isn't class 3 status, and to adjust the mileage without the legal documentation. It is possible that this is the location that was always intended as the cutoff between CL3 and LT, but it's also possible that another location was intended at the time, based on historic highway maps and 1962 imagery (attached). Regardless, it will take time. Added to the cert

Regarding the approach to Platt Rd, I would need the Selectboard to request that I add it to the map indicating that the deed you sent is the documentation that it is public. If they're willing to do that, let me know and I'll give you the lingo to add it to the Cert. I think they will make the motion to add it to the map so please send me the wording. I measure this segment as 0.01 mi.

I wish I could be of more help in suggesting what to look for regarding document that confirms changes to class 3 mileages, but now that changes are pouring in, I'll be struggling to process the easy changes! It's also possible for me to make handwritten changes to the certificate after it has been returned to me, as long as I have the documentation and email confirmation from the Town that I can file with the certificate. And of course I'll do my best to answer any questions you or the Selectboard might have!

Here's the lingo for the mileage changes (based on our phone conversations) for the Mileage Certificate (Part II, #3 Reclassified/Remeasured section):

- -0.02 mi CL2 TH-3 (Franklin Rd) intersection with VT-76 realigned and remeasured, 2014 Project STP RS 0301(1) SA
- -0.03 mi CL3 TH-16 (Old Dock Rd) reconfiguration of intersection with TH-17 and US-7
- 0.02 mi CL3 TH-58 (Beyor Rd) designated Not Up To Standard (NUTS) pursuant to 19 V.S.A. 305(a)
- -0.02 mi CL3 TH-58 (Beyor Rd) remeasured
- -0.01 mi CL3 TH-60 (Lackey Rd) remeasured

The two changes to Beyor Rd (TH-58) are to ensure that the class 3 mileage ends up being 0.05 mi (corresponding to the distance between the centerline of US-7 and the end of pavement on Beyor Rd) when all is adjusted. However, there is an additional 0.02 mi of unmaintained right of way before it connects with the State right of way. (A total of 0.07 mi instead of the 0.09 mi as shown on the Town Highway Map). Unless this unmaintained portion has been formally discontinued or reclassified, the only way for us to exclude it from class 3 mileage totals is to designate it Not Up To Standard (NUTS) so that the 0.02 miles is included with the class 4 mileage totals instead of class 3. This does not change its legal status in any way, so we recommend that the Town clarify its legal status.

TH-17 (Shipyard Rd) did not change length with the reconfiguration of Old Dock Rd at US-7 because it was already considered as extending to the centerline of US-7.

Let me know if you have any questions about any of the changes listed above, or any other potential changes.





I apologize for leaving a message for Andrew King on your answering machine earlier today! I have corresponded with him in the past, and just realized that you are now the Public Works director in Highgate.

VTrans will be sending out the annual Mileage Certificates on January 2nd, and I was hoping to get some clarification on the extent and status of a few Town Highways so that we can include any necessary updates on this year's Certificate. Some of the highways might be easiest to discuss over the phone and with maps in hand, but I'll lay them all out here, starting with the easier questions followed by descriptions of some of the less-straight-forward discrepancies evident in our data:

- 1. Does the attached plan correctly reflect the current extent of TH-30 (Gagne Rd)? The plan corresponds to the highlighted portion of TH-30 in the image below. We've been showing Gagne Rd on the Town Highway Map with a complete loop at the end, but the mileage we have on record (0.07 mi) fell short of a ground measurement of Gagne Rd that included the entire loop (0.73 mi). If the plan still represents the current extent of Gagne Rd, we would update the Town Highway Map to match the plan. On the other hand, if the entire loop is now considered a public ROW, then we would encourage you to submit documentation indicating as much so that it could be added to the map and the mileage totals. Either way, knowing the precise terminus of Gagne Rd will help us confirm the measure and update it if necessary.
- 2. The VTrans Mapping Section just became aware of the 2014(ish) project along Franklin Rd, which realigned its intersection with VT-78. Those plans take into account the current alignment, as well as pinpointing the Highgate-Franklin Town Line, putting the current length at 3397.45 m (2.11 mi) instead of 2.15 mi that we have on record. I've attached the pages corresponding to the intersection with VT-78 and the town line, but can provide the full set if you would like. I can preload this adjustment onto the Certificate, unless you know of some additional information that suggests the mileage should be different.
- 3. Beyor Rd (TH-58) and Lackey Rd (TH-60) are the remnants remaining after I-89 was built, and our mileages on record do not appear to match the mapped and/or maintained portions of these two highways. The discrepancy with Beyor Rd might be due to several factors, though I think the last (a likely error in our record keeping) is the most significant. One possibility is that we do not show an additional "approach" to Beyor Rd that is shown on the interstate plans (but not in the current parcel data), and another is that Beyor Rd doesn't appear to extend the full length of the relinquished right of way. The "oddity" in our records is that in 1966 we describe a change where "old" TH-58 (0.05 mi) was eliminated by the interstate construction (see "old" TH-58 in the 4th image below from 1960) and added 0.04 mi "new" TH-58 as part of old SA-4 (i.e. now Beyor Rd). I believe the 0.09 mi reflects the sum of the "old" and "new" TH-58. Can you shed any light on any of these possibilities? Can you also confirm that Lackey Rd terminates where it intersects the State ROW? You can view the State ROW on this map service (and the parcel data is also available if you peruse the available layers). http://arcg.is/1nGK9K0
- 4. Old Dock Rd TH-16 used to intersect US-7, but now intersects Shipyard Rd (TH-17) instead (based on Stop signs). Older maps suggest the opposite, which might partially explain why the mileage for Old Dock Rd is a little higher than measured, and that of Shipyard Rd is lower than as measured. However, these possibilities also depend on whether I have the correct information about where both town highways end (based on parcel data that can be viewed with our road centerline data via the same map service as above: http://arcg.is/0fSbq8. Can you shed any light on this?
- 5. Last (I hope)... is Waugh Farm Rd (TH-38). Do you know where the transition between TH-38 and LT-5 should be mapped? The measure we have on record doesn't seem to correspond with any obvious landmarks, but I suspect it should. The same map service shows our road centerline data that possibly overshoots the actual end of the class 3 portion.






Intersection of Franklin Rd with VT-78






