

A regular meeting of the St. Albans City Council was held on Monday, February 8, 2021, at 6:30 pm via remote teleconference.

A motion was made by Alderman Spooner; seconded by Alderman Pelkey to discontinue the portion of Crest Road within the City limits. Vote was unanimous, 6-0.

8. Public Hearing and Opening of Cota Court, C. Sawyer (D&V).

A motion was made by Alderman Spooner; seconded by Alderwoman Laddison to approve attached certificate of completion and opening of Cota Court. Vote was unanimous, 6-0.

9. <u>Certification of Highway Mileage, C. Sawyer (D&V)</u>

A motion was made by Alderman Spooner; seconded by Alderman McCarthy to approve certification of highway mileage. Vote was unanimous, 6-0.

10. Public Hearing for Spectrum Youth Services VCDP grant application, C. Sawyer.

Mr. Sawyer stated that the City has been approached by Spectrum Youth Services to sponsor a grant to be used for a new youth center on Lake Street. It would provide a youth drop-in center and other services beneficial to youths in the community and be used to fund operations and services. In order to access these VCDP funds, a public hearing is required. Mr. Sawyer stated that there's a draft of the application included in the packet and the amount they are seeking is \$500,000 to fund operation expenses. He stated that there are some representatives from Spectrum present and introduced Mark Redmond, the Director.

Mark Redmond introduced himself and David Brace, Finance Director for Spectrum Youth Services. He explained that they have been working in St. Albans for about 5 years and the Department of Children & Families asked them to hire some staff who would work with young people in the foster system in Franklin County. St. Albans has young children that really need the help that Spectrum can offer. They raised the funds to open a drop-in center which is very similar to the existing center in Burlington. They can do their laundry, look for work, use the internet get help going back to school, take a shower, find a mentor and have a hot meal. Mr. Redmond stated that Spectrum is leasing space at 223 Lake Street and should be able to open within 2 weeks. They already hired a manager and have two recovery coaches on staff as well as an AmeriCorps worker. The drop in center in Burlington starts with people at age 17 but at the advice of NCSS, DSS, the hospital and VT Adult Learning, they will allow younger children in the St. Albans center and begin working with children at age 14. The Notch will provide healthcare, NCSS will provide mental health services and job support, VT Adult Learning will provide tutoring and the Howard Center will provide addiction support. They have many pieces in place and need the physical space. Mr. Redmond explained that they received some large donations and the board made a commitment to stay open for 3 years no matter what happens. Acquiring this grant could extend their commitment in St. Albans for 7 years.

Mayor Smith asked Mr. Brace what he expects their annual budget to be for the facility. Mr. Brace responded that they are expecting about \$300,000 in annual operating costs and 2/3 of that is personnel. Mr. Redmond added that they are holding a Spectrum Sleep Out on March 26th which raises about \$300,000 per year. Mr. Cloud and Mayor Smith will be participating. Mr. Spooner stated that this is a great program with a proven leadership team and noted he will also be sleeping outside on March 26th. Mr. McCarthy stated that there has been a gap in the services that the City has had for youth in the community and what Spectrum brings is experience and professionalism and a proven program.

Mr. Spooner asked if there's a way people can volunteer whether it's at the facility or being a mentor. Mr. Redmond responded that there will definitely be volunteer opportunities and meal trains.

Mayor Smith asked for public comment. Mr. Scheffler thanked Mr. Redmond for the great work they're doing.

11. Resolution for VCDP grant application, C. Sawyer (D&V).

Mr. Sawyer stated that the motion authorizes the City to file an application on behalf of Spectrum Youth Services. He will be the contact person and Dominic Cloud is the Chief Executive Officer. Mayor Smith asked if the application would be submitted for the April 9th meeting. Mr. Sawyer responded affirmatively. Mayor Smith asked Mr. Sawyer what the expectation is for a response. Mr. Sawyer responded that they should have the results within a couple of weeks.

A motion was made by Alderman Pelkey; seconded by Alderwoman Bessette to approve VCDP grant application for Spectrum Youth Services as outlined by Chip Sawyer. Vote was unanimous, 6-0.
