



Order and Report of Selectboard, Town of Charleston



Re: Batchelder Road, November 2019

Pursuant to V.S.A. Title 19, a public hearing was held on November 14, 2019 at 6:00 pm at the Charleston Town Clerk's office with regard to taking action as described below to reclassify the following town highway located entirely within the Town of Charleston:

Reclassify the .63 mile Class 4 section of Town Highway 19, which begins at VT Route 5A, from a Class 4 highway to a Legal Trail. This section of TH19 is known as Batchelder Road.

Resolved that if the Selectboard determines that the public good, safety, necessity and convenience of the inhabitants for the Town of Charleston requires that said highway be downgraded, this action will be so ordered.

Prior notice as required by law was duly provided by certified mail to all adjoining landowners and interested parties on October 15, 2019:

- Deborah Lussier Trust (adjoining landowner)
- Jackson Allen (adjoining landowner)

Notice was hand-delivered to the Charleston Planning Commission on the same day. Also on October 15th, notice was further provided by posting at the Charleston Town Clerk, East and West Charleston Post Offices, Scampy's Deli, and Charlestonvt.org, and notice was published in the Chronicle, the newspaper of record, in the October 23, 2019 edition.

Selectboard Chair Glenn Peterson opened the November 14th hearing by stating that the reclassification had been requested by all adjoining landowners on this section of the road.

There were no residents, property owners or other members of the public in attendance. The only testimony was a letter from adjoining landowner Jackson Allen in support of the proposal. The Selectboard agreed to take up the matter at their regular business meeting that night at 7:00 pm, and the matter was on the publicly-noticed Selectboard Meeting Agenda. Members of the Selectboard conducted a site visit on October 15, 2019, pursuant to statute.

At the November 14th Selectboard meeting, a motion was made by Mr. Young to reclassify the .63 mile section to a legal trail thereby restricting motorized vehicle access to abutting landowners only, seconded by Mr. Peterson and unanimously approved. The Selectboard offers the following reasons for their decision:

Regarding the proposal to reclassify the Class 4 section of Batchelder Road to a Legal Trail, and the public hearing held earlier that evening on the matter, board members have heard no objections. It is the judgement of the Selectboard that the necessity and convenience of current and future landowners abutting this road advise that the town maintain a right-of-way to ensure access to affected properties. A legal trail would maintain this right-of-way.

It is also the judgement of the Selectboard that the two adjoining landowners have endured excessive damage and vandalism to the road and roadsides, mostly due to ATV use, and reclassification to a legal trail would address this ongoing problem by permitting only adjoining landowners to use motorized vehicles on the road—a restriction set by state statute on legal trails. Further, reclassification to a legal trail lessens maintenance obligations on a road used by only two landowners, an important consideration for taxpayers. The board does not feel that reclassification presents an inconvenience to current landowners or the public.

It is therefore the decision of the Town of Charleston Selectboard that the 0.63 miles of TH #19 known as Batchelder Rd, beginning at VT Route 5A, shall be reclassified to a legal trail, and added to Legal Trail #5. As a result, the length of LT #5 increases from 0.23 miles to 0.86 miles. Correspondingly, the Class 4 portion of TH #19 reduces from 1.07 miles to 0.44 miles.


