


## § 305. Measurement and inspection

- (a) After reasonable notice to the selectboard, a representative of the agency may measure and inspect the class 1, 2, and 3 town highways in each town to verify the accuracy of the records on file with the agency. Upon request, the selectboard or their designee shall be permitted to accompany the representative of the agency during the measurement and inspection. The agency shall notify the town when any highway, or portion of a highway, does not meet the standards for its assigned class. If the town fails, within one year, to restore the highway or portion of the highway to the accepted standard, or to reclassify, or to discontinue, or develop an acceptable schedule for restoring to the accepted standards, the agency for purposes of apportionment under section 306 of this title shall deduct the affected mileage from that assigned to the town for the particular class of the road in question.
- (b) Annually, on or before February 10, the selectboard shall file with the town clerk a sworn statement of the description and measurements of all class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails then in existence, including any special designation such as a throughway or scenic highway. When class 1, 2, 3, or 4 town highways, trails, or unidentified corridors are accepted, discontinued, or reclassified, a copy of the proceedings shall be filed in the town clerk's office and a copy shall be forwarded to the agency.
- (c) All class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails shall appear on the town highway maps by July 1, 2015.
- (d) At least 45 days prior to first including a town highway or trail that is not clearly observable by physical evidence of its use as a highway or trail and that is legally established prior to February 10, 2006 in the sworn statement required under subsection (b) of this section, the legislative body of the municipality shall provide written notice and an opportunity to be heard at a duly warned meeting of the legislative body to persons owning lands through which a highway or trail passes or abuts.
- (e) The agency shall not accept any change in mileage until the records required to be filed in the town clerk's office by this section are received by the agency. A request by a municipality to the agency for a change in mileage shall include a description of the affected highway or trail, a copy of any surveys of the affected highway or trail, minutes of meetings at which the legislative body took action with respect to the changes, and a current town highway map with the requested deletions and additions sketched on it. A survey shall not be required for class 4 town highways that are legally established prior to February 10, 2006. All records filed with the agency are subject to verification in accordance with subsection (a) of this section.
- (f) The selectboard of any town who are aggrieved by a finding of the agency concerning the measurement, description, or classification of a town highway may appeal to the transportation board by filing a notice of appeal with the executive secretary of the transportation board.
- (g) The agency shall provide each town with a map of all of the highways in that town together with the mileage of each class 1, 2, 3, and 4 highway, as well as each trail, and such other information as the agency deems appropriate

Thanks for the old TH-8 documents! Everything is all set to connect the gap on the map, and I will pre-load the remeasurement of TH-8 on the 2016 Mileage Certificate.

Regarding the remeasurement of TH-1, the realignment due to the new bridge slightly shortened the highway, and this small adjustment was simply never included on a Mileage Certificate. It is not uncommon for remeasurements to be initiated by us, and occurred more frequently when the Mapping Section was regularly conducting complete field inventories for towns (up until the early '90s). I will also pre-load this remeasurement (-0.01 mi) onto the Certificate.

I've attached another map of Davis Drive (TH-63). Can you verify that the blue line corresponds to the currently maintained portion of TH-63 (my best guess based on your description below), or describe how it should be adjusted? Will the Craftsbury Selectboard be able to discontinue the untraveled portion of TH-63 within a year? If so, it would be simplest to process the change on next year's certificate. Otherwise, I will pre-load the NUTS change onto this year's certificate, which can then be updated whenever the discontinuance eventually occurs.

Hello Bruce.

I wanted to touch base with you again regarding the Martin Rd (TH-8) historic documents, and also to let you know about a remeasurement of TH-1 (S Craftsbury Rd, class 2) and ask you about the status of Davis Drive (TH-63).

I've pasted bits from our last two communications regarding Martin Rd below.

Bridge #32 and a short portion of TH-1 (S Craftsbury Rd) were relocated sometime around 1996 (see attached map), but we have not yet included that change in the VTrans Mapping Section records. We will pre-load a change of -0.01 mile for class 2 TH-1 onto Craftsbury's 2016 Certificate of Highway Mileage, unless you have any additional information that suggests it should be otherwise.

Regarding Davis Dr (class 3, TH-63), it has come to our attention that the roadway beyond the first driveway (mobile home address #33) is an unmaintained grassy lane (see attached map). Has there been a reclassification or discontinuance of this portion of TH-63 that the VTrans Mapping Section is unaware of, or is there a plan to do so? Alternatively, are there plans to bring the entire highway back to class 3 standards? Is the initial gravel portion of TH-63 still maintained by the town? If there has been no formal change to the status of TH-63, and there are no immediate plans to do so, then we recommend that the unmaintained portion be added to the 2016 Certificate of Highway Mileage as "Not Up To Standard" so that state aid funding will not be applied to an unmaintained highway. If you clarify for us which portions of TH-63 are maintained by the town, we can preload the change onto the mileage certificate. The length of TH-63 up to the driveway of mobile home #33 is 0.03 mile, but please let us know if the town maintains anything beyond this point.

If you have any questions about the changes I have discussed above, please let me know. Thanks for helping us keep our records up-to-date!


Hi Bruce,

They are dated 1806, and seem to be conveyances of property between individuals rather than public rights of way. Since the page 243 scan is from the year 1806, maybe the records I am seeking are from another book (Layout Records Book 2)? Or maybe there is a typo in one of the page numbers written on the road detail scan (attached). The earlier date has the greater page number. Can you have someone try to find the relevant records referenced on the road detail and scan them for me? Hopefully the documents will indicate how we should proceed to make sure that Martin Rd and Coburn Hill Trail connect in our records as well as yours.

Bruce,

Martin Road is really in the same boat as Coburn Hill Road. There are

2 old layouts that were never discontinued that intersect in the vicinity of the end of the maintained roadway, but there is no definition of "Martin Road" which of course is just a recent label that has been applied to that right of way without any definition. As far as I'm concerned, the 1856 layout that Coburn Hill Trail intersects may or may not be considered part of "Martin Road" but does constitute access to the travelled route. I'm attaching a detail from the survey that shows what I just described and gives references.
