Thank you for the prompt submission of your Highway Mileage Certificate.

However, we feel that there is 0.14 mile that should be but is not included in your mileage figures.

Because of the relocation during the Openshero - Craftsbury construction project No. 3 OP35(1) on former State Aid Highways 3 and 5, in Craftsbury, there would be two sections of former State Aid Highway leading from the start of the relocation on both of these highways to the old junction of State Aid Highways 3 and 5, that should revert to the Town System.

As these sections are necessary to complete the connection between former State Aid No. 3 and present State Aid No. 2, it is felt that the omission from the mileage was just an oversight.

If you could add 0.14 mile to Town Highways on your copy of the Highway Mileage Certificate, we shall do the same on the copy submitted.
