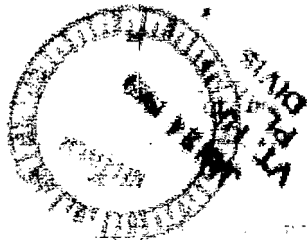

See 19. Measurement of highways. The selectmen of this town, with the assistance of a representative of the state highway board shall measure the traveled highways defined in section 1 of this title, at least once every ten years, not including post roads and trails. Annually, on or before February 15, the selectmen shall file with the town clerk a sworn statement of the mileage and construction of all highways, including all new highways built, and all highways damaged, during the year previous thereto, not including post roads and trails. When highways are discontinued by statutory procedure, a copy of the proceedings shall be forwarded to the board. When new highways are built or added pursuant to the statute, a copy of the laws enacted authorizing the selectmen's certificate of construction, including a detailed description of said highways, shall be forwarded to the board. No new mileage shall be accepted for the purpose of this chapter if such records are not recorded. If the certified copy of the sworn statement for a town called for by this section fails to reach the board on March 15th, then the board shall use the mileage shown on the previous certificate properly filed.

See 16. Forwarding certificate of mileage. The certificate showing the highway mileage of towns under section 13 of this title shall be forthwith recorded in the office of the town clerk, who, within five days shall forward a certified copy thereof to the board which shall verify the same to the secretary of state.

The substance of each item, with the substance of a representative of the town highway board shall require the town highway board to submit 1 of the 10, or such other copy of the plans, and including past records and trials, annually, on or before February 15, the substance and the town shall submit a sworn statement of the description and measurement of all highways, including all town highways, and all highways shown on the map, during the year previous thereto, and including past records and trials. The certificate showing the highway mileage of towns under section 16 of this title shall be furnished recorded in the office of the town clerk, who, within five days, shall forward a certified copy thereof to the board which shall verify the same in the secretary of state.

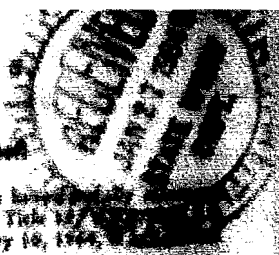

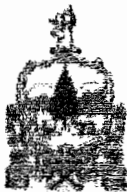
