I hope all is well.

I've got something I've noticed in the RDS data which I figured I would forward to you for your review/consideration.

A few years ago I noticed some AOTCLASS problems with certain arcs along South Hill Rd in Moretown. The problem is still present in the latest data. Not sure if you "guys" have had a chance to review it, but I believe the following arcs should have an AOTCLASS of 3.

FAID=500230600324 FAID=500230600325

These were both class 4 in the original RDS data.

I believe 500230600322 reaffirms my contention (tagged as Class 4...floating in space). It is also consistent with how the road crew manages the road (grading, plowing, ditching, etc).
