TOWN OF NORTHFIELD SELECTBOARD MINUTES November 8,1999



I. ROLL CALL: Chair Brad Denny, Selectmen Lin Christian, Richmond Moot, Don Wallace and Lynn Sanders. Manager Paul McGinley, Supt. Bill Lyon, John Donahue of the Northfield Transcript, and Rob Goodrich of Trans-Video. Others present include Police Chief Cucinelli, Todd Boucher, Jeff Hatch, Marty Daniels, and Caroline Gillespie.

Chair Denny called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

- II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: October 25, 1999 (Regular Meeting)-- Motion by R. Moot, 2nd L. Christian, to approve minutes. Motion passed 4-0-1 with D. Wallace abstaining.
- III. APPROVAL OF BILLS: Warrant #0900--11/12/99--\$70,748.22; Motion by D. Wallace, 2nd R. Moot, to approve warrant #0900. Motion passed 5-0-0.

IV. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:

- a. Larry Drown--Public Safety; this portion of the agenda has been delayed until Mr. Drown arrives.
- b. Chief Cucinelli addressed the Board and stated he was back in Town service.

V. MANAGER'S REPORT

- a. Status Report: Various Projects
 - 1. Mgr. McGinley informed the Board that a Land Use Permit has been granted for Cabot Hosiery to begin dying and discharging activities. The discharge will go to the Village Treatment Plant.
 - 2. Barry T. Chouinard has applied for a Land Use Permit for expansion. The expansion is to house facilities to pre-treat wastewater. There is an opportunity for public hearing in the future if requested.
 - 3. Mgr. McGinley also informed the Board that the budget process has begun.
- b. Right-of-way for Hockman Hill Bridge--Mgr. McGinley informed the Board that he has encountered difficulties in obtaining the necessary right-of-way for the project. Mgr. McGinley has solicited help from a Board member to obtain this right-of-way. Selectman Sanders volunteered to help the Manager. This is a seven-year bridge project. The Town is 2 ½ to 3 years into the project. The Manager has suggested that it will be cheaper for the Town if an amicable solution can be reached.

VI. SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC WORKS:

a. Various Projects: Status Report: None.

VII. SELECTBOARD:

- a. Interview of Planning Commission candidates: Todd Boucher, Vermont-born and raised, applied to the Board for the open position on the Commission. He expressed a desire to become involved in the Town. Jeff Hatch, life-long resident of Northfield and business owner, expressed his interest in the open position. Motion by R. Moot, 2nd L. Sanders, to appoint Jeff Hatch to the opening on the Planning Commission left by the resignation of Mary Dysinger. Motion passed 5-0-0. Marty Daniels, also a life-long Northfield resident, approached the Board with an interest in serving on the Commission. Motion by R. Moot, 2nd L. Sanders, to appoint Marty Daniels to the vacancy on the Commission occasioned by the resignation of John Donahue. Motion passed 5-0-0. Selectman Sanders requested that Mr. Donahue attend the next meeting to help with the new members.
- b. Acceptance as Road--Northview Road (formerly known as South Road); motion by D. Wallace, 2nd R. Moot, to accept Northview Road. Motion passed 5-0-0.
- c. Elect Vice-Chairman: motion by D. Wallace, 2nd L. Sanders, to nominate Selectman Moot as Vice-Chairman. Motion by L. Sanders, 2nd B. Denny, to nominate Selectman Christian as Vice-Chairman. Selectman Moot was elected 3-1-1 with L. Sanders voting for L. Christian and L. Christian abstaining.
- d. Property for Tax Sale--Authorization of Purchases for Town; motion by D. Wallace, 2nd R. Moot, to authorize the Manager to bid on properties at the tax sale up to the cost of the tax lien plus penalties and costs. **Motion passed 5-0-0.** Chair Denny volunteered to assist the Manager in this matter.

VIII. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: Non-agenda items:

- a. Caroline Gillespie addressed the Board regarding the street name change from Edson to Kingston. She specifically requested as to when the change was made. A general discussion ensued, but no concrete explanation was offered as to the change by the Selectboard.
- b. Selectman Christian raised issues for the Board regarding the search for Town Manager. She has suggested the Board not use VLCT's service regarding the Manager search. Chair Denny explained the \$5,000 cost as divided between advertising (\$2500) and application collection (\$2500.) The service by VLCT at \$2500 also includes the necessary background investigations as well as the collection of applications.
- c. At the reminder of Rob Goodrich, the Board congratulated the Northfield Girls and Boys Soccer teams for their recent championships.
- IX. ADJOURNMENT: Motion by D. Wallace, 2nd L. Christian, to adjourn. Motion passed 5-0-0.


