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



I. ROLL CALL: Chair Libby Hambleton, Trustees Samantha Baraw, Thomas McCarney, Richard Suitor, and James Wilson. Also present were Village Manager Nanci Allard, Chris Alger (Northfield Fire Department), Lawton Rutter (Northfield Ambulance Service), Alana Richard (Northfield Ambulance Service), and Scott Corse (VPPSA).

Chair Hambleton called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

II. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION (Scheduled)

a. Scott Corse, Vermont Public Power Supply Authority (VPPSA): Ludlow Biomass Plant. This is about a proposed project in Ludlow, Vermont. Mr. Corse gave a presentation on this specific project as well the general benefits of expanding efforts in Vermont to use biomass (i.e. wood) to generate electricity.

III. ACTION ITEMS

- a. Approval of Minutes
 - **1. June 24, 2008 (Regular Meeting):** Motion by Trustee Suitor, seconded by Trustee Wilson, to approve the minutes. **Motion passed 5-0-0.**
- b. Approval of Bills
 - **1. Warrant #02-09.** Motion by Trustee Wilson, seconded by Trustee Suitor, to approve Warrant #02-09 in the amount of \$335,341.32. **Motion passed 5-0-0.**
 - 2. Validation of Warrant #01-09B: Motion by Trustee McCarney, seconded by Trustee Wilson, to validate Warrant #01-09B in the amount of \$275,926.00. Motion passed 5-0-0.
- c. Sidewalk Paving. Superintendant of Public Works William Lyon developed a proposal to repair the sidewalks around the Village Common. Trustee McCarney has concerns on this item with regard to ownership of the existing sidewalks. This is part of the Village Common Project; we have tried for state grants for several years and have never been selected. Manager Allard will be working to determine ownership of these areas. Our crew will do what they can. Motion by Trustee McCarney, seconded by Trustee Suitor, to approve the proposal contingent upon Manager Allard getting the needed easements from property owners. Motion passed 5-0-0. The Board will hold a site visit on the Village Common prior to the next regular meeting (07/29/08) in order to view the situation.
- d. Tuckaway Lane. We now have the legal paperwork from Thomas Tucker deeding Tuckaway Lane to Northfield Village. Manager Allard recommends that we accept this pending approval from our attorneys. We do not yet have the all of the necessary utility easements. Once we get the easements and attorney approval, Tuckaway Lane will be added to the list of Village Streets.

- b. Richard Madison and Andrew McMichael, DeWitt Clinton Masonic Lodge: "Cruise-In" on Village Common. The Masonic Lodge has been soliciting participation from the businesses located on the Common to see if they would be interested in being open for a "cruise in" (antique car show) and if any had objections to the Common being blocked off during the posted time for the event. They have received several positive responses for businesses being open during the event and no negative response regarding the Common being blocked off. They would like use of the Village Common on Saturday, August 2, 2008 from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. They would like to close at least half of the Common from traffic. - 3. Efficiency Vermont Project update. A meeting was held recently. There were reports from some of the larger customers.
