After we received Brattleboro's 2011 Certificate of Highway Mileage, we were notified that a portion of Guilford Street was realigned due to project number BRF 2000(21)S. Specifically, a new bridge was built to bypass the Creamery covered bridge at the end of Guilford Street (Class 2 TH-10) where it intersects VT-9. This resulted in a change in town highway mileage.

The mileage for the section of Class 2 TH-10 between VT-9 and TH-375 (Winston Prouty Wy) is reduced by 0.01 miles.

In reviewing the project plans, it appears that the old right-of-way remains open to the public, but its classification is not specifically identified. Based on the project plans, it appears that the remaining portion does not meet Class 2 or Class 3 town highway standards, and therefore, by default receives the classification of Class 4.

This will add a new Class 4 town highway of 0.09 miles.

I have enclosed a map that shows our interpretation of the new alignments and highway classifications.

Please review and confirm if our interpretation is correct. We would like to include this change on the 2011 Town Highway Map for Brattleboro and properly reflect the current traveled mileage. Please find enclosed a modified Certificate of Highway Mileage based on the interpretation of the changes noted above.

Please feel free to contact me with any questions or comments regarding the proposed mileage changes, or the town highway mapping process in general.


