

CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION AND OPENING

WHEREAS, at Halifax, Vermont, aforesaid, on the 11th day of January, the Selectmen of the Town of Halifax, did unanimously vote to propose that pursuant to Title 19, Vermont Statutes Annotated, Sections 708-712 to LAY OUT as a public highway and a Class III road the following Town Trail, to wit:

"Town Highway #17: Beginning at the intersection of Town Highway No. 3 and Town Highway No. 17 and extending southerly and southwesterly approximately 700 feet to the driveway of Adam A. Adamski III."

WHEREFORE, the Selectmen did order and appoint that on the 11th day of January, 1994, at 7:30 P.M. they would meet at the Halifax Town Office, West Halifax, Vermont, for the purpose of hearing all persons interested in said proposed highway, and for the purpose of examining the premises affected thereby, and did give notice thereof to the following persons who own or are interested in the lands on which said proposed road now lies or abutting on said proposed roadway at their last known addresses:

Adam A. Adamski III Homer K. and Deborah J. Sumner Lewis L. and Laura S. Sumner

And did give notice to the Halifax Planning Commission and did give notice thereof to the voters of the Town of Halifax by posting notices thereon on December 10, 1993 in three public places within the Town and did give notice to the voters of the Town of Halifax by causing a notice to be published in the following newspapers with circulation in Halifax, Vermont: Deerfield Valley News on December 16, 1993; the Green Mountain Courier on December 17, 1993; the Brattleboro Reformer on December 20, 1993 and did leave a copy of such notice with the Halifax Town Clerk.

And on December 8, 1993, all of the Selectmen did examine said premises and did hold a public hearing on January 11, 1994, at 7:30 P.M. at the Halifax Town Office in West Halifax, Vermont, and the following interested parties appeared at the hearing:

Adam A. Adamski III Lewis L. Sumner and Laura S. Sumner

At said hearing the Selectmen heard from each of the parties having an interest in the road to be re-classified from a Class IV highway and public trail to a Class III highway.

THE SELECTMEN FIND THE FOLLOWING FACTS:

1. That the highway is a trail three (3) rods wide all as determined by public hearing and proceedings recorded August 1, 1972 in Volume 28, Pages 495-502 of the Halifax Land Records.

- 2. That the trail petitioned herein by the Selectmen to be reclassified as a Class III highway is approximately 700 feet in length.
- 3. That since the road was reclassified as a trail by public hearing and proceedings recorded August 1, 1972 Adam A. Adamski III has built a new residence on a portion of the property abutting Town Highway #17.
- 4. That Adam A. Adamski III wrote a letter and appeared at a meeting of the Board of Selectmen held on December 7, 1993 to request that the town take over and maintain that portion of Town Highway #17 as far as his residence.
- 5. That Adam A. Adamski III has at his expense brought that portion of Town Highway #17 as far as his residence up to the Town of Halifax highway standards.
- 6. That those present at the hearing voiced their opinions in favor of the roadway being re-classified as a Class III highway and maintained as such.
- 7. That there were no objections to the roadway being re-classified as a Class III highway and maintained as such.

THEREFORE, the selectmen were of the opinion and did so vote that the convenience of the inhabitants and the convenience and public good requires that the following TRAIL be LAID OUT and re-classified a Class III public highway and maintained as such:

"Town Highway #17: Beginning at the intersection of Town Highway No. 3 and Town Highway No. 17 and extending southerly and southwesterly approximately 700 feet to the driveway of Adam A. Adamski III."

AND, the said Selectmen did then determine and vote that no damage was sustained by any person owning or interested in lands through which said proposed roadway runs or abuts.

THEREFORE, it is ORDERED by the undersigned Selectmen that the trail as above described be re-classified as a Class III public highway and maintained as such.
