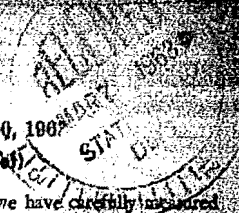

SUBJECT: Reselection in the Town of Halifax.

The proposed reselection here runs from the hamlet of West Halifax northeasterly to the Whitingham Town Line. From this point it is 0.40 mile to a state-aid road in the Town of Whitingham which has not been included in the selection. An actual traffic count on this road during 1957 shows 32 vehicles per day, with a drop to 20 vehicles per day at the mid-point. I do not think that this would qualify as a trunk line highway from town to town with only 30 vehicles per day.
