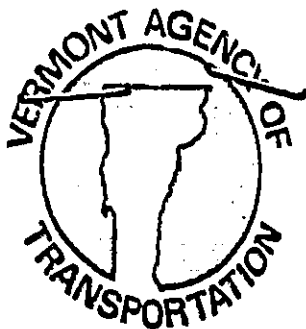

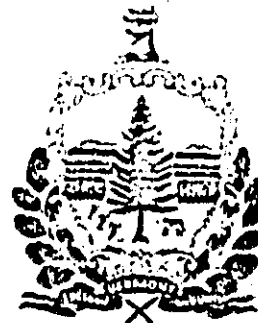

Gentlemen:

Enclosed is the Certificate of Highway Mileage for your town for the year ending February 10, 1983. We have made several changes in the Certificate this year. You will note that this new form does not require notarization. Gentlemen:

In accordance with Title 19, V.S.A., Section 15, as amended, all the traveled highways in your town were measured in 1980 by Mr. Bemis, Selectman and Mr. Putnam, Road Foreman, with Mr. Chabot, Road Inventory Chief, of this office.

SELECTMEN'S MEETING--August 8, 1979

The Halifax Board of Selectmen met at the Town Clerk's office Wednesday, August 8, 1979 at 8:00 P. M. with Lewis Sumner, Fred Crosby and Rodney Bemis present.

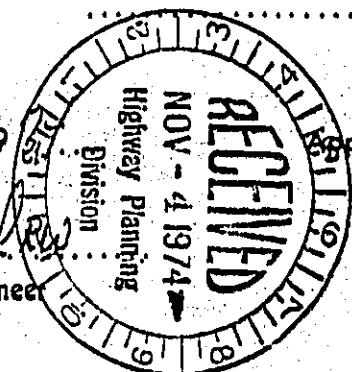
