#### JOINT MEETING

Chairman Linc Divoll called the meeting to order at 7:06 P.M. in the Town Hall Conference Room.

#### LIFE INSURANCE DISABILITY

The Manager's memo of January 6, 1993 was reviewed and some history on this policy which goes back about 27+ years was provided. This policy has been used very little as many employees have accumulated sick leave up to the 120 days maximum; when used it only pays \$60. a week. A proposal for 2/3rds of salary after 30 days has been obtained and a cost comparison made. This is a much better program for the employees. There was a consensus that the proposed plan should be put out for bid, looked into for more detail and obtain some feed-back from the employees.

Thomas MacPhee made a motion to continue this study on the Life and Disability Policy and bring it back before the Joint Boards. Seconded by: C. Bergmann. The motion carried.

Changes in the Blue Cross/Blue Shield rates and the agreement made between the employees and the Boards to pay the difference between the JY and E9 plans were discussed. Premium changes have been less than \$3.00 in the past two years. Board members agreed to continue on the same basis and when the rates are revised in July adjustments will be made in the employee's payroll checks.

#### MANAGER'S EVALUATION .,

Board members continue to work on the Manager's evaluation and this will be tabled to a future meeting.

### DEEDING OF CLACE DRIVE

There was a deeding of property back in 1979 from LaHaise and DiBernardo to the Village for a right-of-way to the water tower. Attorney Buckley has prepared a description of the road so that it can be taken over as a Town street so that both Boards can take the necessary action to document this. Catherine Bergmann made a motion to approve and sign the Warranty Deed to turn Clace Drive over to the Town. Seconded by: C. Jarras. The motion carried.

Thornton Lillie made a motion to approve and sign the Certificate of Highway Opening for Clace Drive. Seconded by: J. Mullen. The motion carried. Property Transfer forms were also documented and signed.

#### OTHER BUSINESS

There was none to come before the Joint Boards.


Catherine Bergmann made a motion to adjourn this meeting at 7:32 P.M. Seconded by: T. MacPhee. The motion carried.

Beginning at the northeasterly corner of Lot No. 141 as shown on a plan entitled, " PLAN OF PROPOSED STANLEY G. GRISWOLD DEVELOPMENT", Bellows Falls, Vermont dated August, 1958; Scale 1"= 60 feet as prepared by Dufresne-Henry Engineering Co. and filed in the Rockingham Land Records.

Thence North 87° 50' West along the northerly bounds of said Lot No. 141 now owned by Douglas Brent 120.2 feet to a point at the northwesterly corner of said Lot No. 141;

Thence North 01° 04' East along lands of DiBernardo and LaHaise 29.2 feet to a point;
