Title 19. V. S. A. Section 305 Added 1985

SEC. 305. MEASUREMENT OF HIGHWAYS

(a) A representative of the agency in the presence of the selectmen or their designee shall measure and inspect the class 1, 2 and 3 town highways in each town at least once every ten years. The agency shall notify the town when any highway, or portion of a highway, does not meet the standards for its assigned class. If the town falls, within one year, to restore the highway or portion of the highway to the accepted standard, or to reclassify, or to discontinue, or develop an acceptable schedule for restoring to the accepted standards, the agency for purposes of apportionment under section 306 of this title shall deduct the affected mileage from that assigned to the town for the particular class of the road in question.

(b) Annually, on or before February 10, the selectmen shall, after review by a representative of the agency, file with the town clerk a sworn statement of the description and measurements of all class 1, 2 and 3 town nighways, then in existence, including any special designation such as a throughway or scenic highway. When class 1, 2 or 3 town-highways are accepted, discontinued, or reclassified, a copy of the proceedings shall be filed in the town clerk's office and a copy shall be forwarded to the agency.

(c) The agency shall not accept any change in mileage until the records required to be filed in the town clerk's office by this section are received by the agency.

(d) The selectmen of any town who are aggrieved by a finding of the aceday carcaining an easurement, description or classification of a town highway may appear to the board by filling a notice of appear with the executive secretary of the board.

Title 19, V. S. A. Section 2502 Added 1985

PLANNING ON

Sec. 2502. TOWN SCENIC ROADS, DESIGNATION AND DISCONTINUANCE

(a) On recommendation of the planning commission of a municipality, or on the inlitiative of the legislative body of a municipality, a legislative body may, after one public hearing warned for the purpose, designate or discontinue any town highway or portion of a town highway, as a town scenic highway. Such action by the legislative body may be petitioned by the registered voters of the municipality pursuant to the provisions of section 1973 of Title 24.

(b) A town scenic road may be reconstructed or improved in a manner constructed or improved in a manner constructed with the standards established by the transportation board, pursuant to section 425 of Title iO. A class I, 2 or 3 scenic highway shall still be eligible to receive aid pursuant to the provisions of this title.

(c) The legislative body of a municipality may appeal for a variance from standards promulgated by the transportation board, in these appeals the board's decision small be final.





On June 18, 1990, I sent Mr. Wheatley, Planning Engineer, a letter in which the Town of Stratton requested 2.12 miles of T.H. #10, from T.H. #1 to the junction of T.H. #8, and 4.46 miles of T.H. #8, from the junction of T.H. #10 to T.H. #2, be reclassified from Class III to Class II town highway.

These highways are used quite heavily by tourists, local citizens, and skiers, to travel between Wilmington, Dover, Stratton and Winhall. It is my recommendation that the classification of these highways, be upgraded to Class II.
