



Hearing on Discontinuance of Lamb Road May 22, 1984

Those present: Irene Elders, Alan Plumb, Kenneth Plumb, Dave Hume, Arnold Wilson, Ship Forbes, Janice Gordon, Charles Hale, Mr. Lamb, Mr. Hunter and Linda Bargfrede, Clerk.

At 8:00 P.M. Alan Plumb, Chairman of the Board of Selectmen, recessed the regular monthly Selectmen's Meeting to hold a hearing on Mr. Robert Lamb's request that the Town of Andover discontinue Town Highway #42. Irene explained that highway #42 is approximately 200' long and that Mr. Lamb owns the property on both sides of the road.

Charles Hale mentioned that the land would have to be returned to Mr. Lamb. Irene Elders will look into the legal procedure for returning the land back to Mr. Lamb.
