## WARRANTY DEED

CURCHEE, INC., a Vermont corporation with its principal place of business in Hartford, in the County of Windsor and State of Vermont, Grantor, in the consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other good and valuable considerations paid to its full satisfaction by the TOWN OF HARTFORD, a municipal corporation located in Hartford, County of Windsor and State of Vermont, Grantee, by these presents do freely GIVE, GRANT, SELL, CONVEY, AND CONFIRM unto the said Grantee, the TOWN OF HARTFORD, and its successors and assigns forever, all right and title which SUNRISE VALLEY AT QUECHEE, INC., or its successors and assigns, has to certain strip of land fifty (50') feet in width to be used for highway purposes along roadways on lands and premises owned by the Grantor in the Town of Hartford, in the County of Windsor and State of Vermont, described as follows, viz:

The paved portions of the roads through the development known as Sunrise Valley at Quechee, Inc. and consisting of portions of Sunrise Circle as shown on a survey of lots entitled "Survey and Subdivision for Property of Alan E. Dunklee and Peter W. Robes, Quechee - Hartland Road and W. Gilson Ave., Quechee, Vermont" prepared by Hathorn Surveys, Proj. No. 31486 dated 1-11-86 and last revised 3-19-86 and recorded in the Hartford Map Book 6 at Page 99.

The paved portion of the road herein conveyed is more particularly described as follows:

That portion of Sunrise Circle being 50 feet in width the centerline thereof extending in a westerly direction from the intersection of Sunrise Circle and Cross Street a distance of approximately 1,085 feet, said portion of Sunrise Circle being bounded by Lots 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 29, 30, 31, 32, 39, 40 and 41, as shown and depicted on the above referenced survey, to which survey reference may be made for further particulars of description of that portion of Sunrise Circle conveyed hereby, meaning hereby to convey to the Town of Hartford all of the remaining portion of Sunrise Circle.

The lands and premises herein conveyed are a portion of the lands and premises conveyed to Sunrise Valley at Quechee, Inc. by Alan E. Dunklee and Peter W. Robes by Warranty Deed dated April 11, 1986, recorded in Book 123 at Pages 344-346 of the Hartford Land Records.

The purpose of this deed is to convey the lands and premises above described to the Town of Hartford for use as a public highway pursuant to Title 19 of the Vermont Statutes Annotated.

This conveyance is made subject to the terms and conditions of State of Vermont Land Use Permit Number 3W0494 dated September 20, 1986 and recorded in Book 121 at Pages 380-383 of the Hartford Land Records, and as subsequently amended and is further made subject to all local zoning and subdivision permits.

Included in this conveyance are any reserved rights to drain and flow surface water from the culverts and ditches in the
