19 V.S.A. § 305. Measurement and inspection

Policy, Planially -Development Division

§ 305. Measurement and inspection

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(a) After reasonable notice to the selectboard, a representative of the agency may measure and inspect the class 1, 2, and 3 town highways in each town to verify the accuracy of the records on file with the agency. Upon request, the selectboard or their designee shall be permitted to accompany the representative of the agency during the measurement and inspection. The agency shall notify the town when any highway, or portion of a highway, does not meet the standards for its assigned class. If the town fails, within one year, to restore the highway or portion of the highway to the accepted standard, or to reclassify, or to discontinue, or develop an acceptable schedule for restoring to the accepted standards, the agency for purposes of apportionment under section 306 of this title shall deduct the affected mileage from that assigned to the town for the particular class of the road in question.

(b) Annually, on or before February 10, the selectboard shall file with the town clerk a sworn statement of the description and measurements of all class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails then in existence, including any special designation such as a throughway or scenic highway. When class 1, 2, 3, or 4 town highways, trails, or unidentified corridors are accepted, discontinued, or reclassified, a copy of the proceedings shall be filed in the town clerk's office and a copy shall be forwarded to the agency.

(c) All class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails shall appear on the town highway maps by July 1, 2015.

(d) At least 45 days prior to first including a town highway or trail that is not clearly observable by physical evidence of its use as a highway or trail and that is legally established prior to February 10, 2006 in the sworn statement required under subsection (b) of this section, the legislative body of the municipality shall provide written notice and an opportunity to be heard at a duly warned meeting of the legislative body to persons owning lands through which a highway or trail passes or abuts.


(e) The agency shall not accept any change in mileage until the records required to be filed in the town clerk's office by this section are received by the agency. A request by a municipality to the agency for a change in mileage shall include a description of the affected highway or trail, a copy of any surveys of the affected highway or trail, minutes of meetings at which the legislative body took action with respect to the changes, and a current town highway map with the requested deletions and additions sketched on it. A survey shall not be required for class 4 town highways that are legally established prior to February 10, 2006. All records filed with the agency are subject to verification in accordance with subsection (a) of this section.

(f) The selectboard of any town who are aggrieved by a finding of the agency concerning the measurement, description, or classification of a town highway may appeal to the transportation board by filing a notice of appeal with the executive secretary of the transportation board.

(g) The agency shall provide each town with a map of all of the highways in that town together with the mileage of each class 1, 2, 3, and 4 highway, as well as each trail, and such other information as the agency deems appropriate.

Discontinuance of Horse Farm Lane

The Selectboard of the Town of Rochester held a warned public hearing on January 22, 2013 at Horse Farm Lane (TH 57), proper notice having been given to adjoining landowners and boards. The hearing was held in order to determine whether the public good and necessity would be served by discontinuing said highway.

TH 57 traverses land owned only by a single landowner and leads only to his residence. No public or private lands exist beyond the end point of the road adjacent to the residence also known as 96 Horse Farm Lane. No public comments against the discontinuance were received at the Public Hearing.


The Selectboard believes the public good and necessity are no longer served by the Town owning rights to TH 57 and continuing to maintain the highway as a public road. We therefore order the discontinuance of TH 57 as hereby described:

Measuring from the extension of the center line of Riverbrook Drive (TH 21) as it crosses on Bridge #34 over the White River, a distance of 50 feet north to the point of beginning of the discontinuance; thence measuring along the centerline of TH 57 a distance of 532 feet to the end point adjacent to the residence at 96 Horse Farm Lane.

If there are changes that occurred before this past year that we have not shown on the Town Highway Map, please let us know so we can update our maps.

Also enclosed is a reduced size copy of your current Town Highway Map and a Certificate of Completion and Opening should you need it to document new town roads. An Adobe form version of the Certificate of Completion and Opening is also available online at ftp://vtransmaps.vermont.gov/Maps/Publications/MileageCertificates/Certificate of Completion and Opening pdf_form.pdf.

In filling out the Mileage Certificate, it is important to:

- >> Enter mileage and classification changes.
- >> If you have no changes, you may simply check the box in PART II of Certificate.
- >> Always sign Part III Town Clerk, Selectmen, etc.

To effectively process all the mileage certificates in a timely manner and to assure the completion of the mileage summaries, it is important that towns submit the certificates on time. Certificates must be postmarked on or before February 20, 2014. Certificates that are postmarked after February 20, 2014 may not be processed.
