TOWN OF SPRINGFIELD ORDER OF DISCONTINUANCE PURSUANT TO 19 V.S.A. CHAPTER 7

WHEREAS, pursuant to 19 V.S.A. Section 708(a), on its own Motion after a citizen's request, the Selectmen commenced proceedings to discontinue a portion of Town Highway #113, also known as Tenney Road, so called, located in Springfield, Vermont, which encircles the dwelling owned by Robert A. Hathaway, Jr. and Kathleen D. Hathaway. A viewing was held of such Road on October 27, 2003, at 5:00 p.m., and a Public Hearing held November 10, 2003, at 6:30 p.m. at the Town Hall, 96 Main Street, to consider testimony and take action. Notice of such viewing and Public Hearing was served on all persons owning or interested in lands through which such highway may pass or abut, along with the Planning Commission and posting a copy in the office of the Town Clerk and further such notice was published in a local newspaper of general circulation in the area not less than 10 days before the time set for said Hearing. Robert A. Hathaway, Jr. and Kathleen D. Hathaway waived said Notice. A copy of the Notice is attached and marked as Exhibit A. A copy of the Waiver is attached and marked as Exhibit B.

WHEREAS, after conducting the viewing of Town highway #113 and taking testimony,

John Follett moved and Douglas Richards seconded

a motion that the Springfield Selectboard hereby finds that the public good, necessity and
convenience of the inhabitants of the Town of Springfield requires that the portion of Town

Highway #113 located within 1,535 feet, more or less, from the house owned by Robert A.

Hathaway, Jr. and Kathleen D. Hathaway be discontinued, giving back to the abutting property

owner, Robert A. Hathaway, Jr. and Kathleen D. Hathaway, any right, title and interest that the

Town may have in said road; subject, however, to the condition that Robert A. Hathaway, Jr. and

Kathleen D. Hathaway deed to the Town of Springfield an easement for Highway purposes over

the parcel depicted on the survey entitled, "Easement Being Conveyed To Town of Springfield by

Robert A. Hathaway Jr. & Kathleen D. Hathaway, Springfield, Vermont," Project No. 03-722 by Gary Rapanotti, L.S., dated October 29, 2003 and revised November 4, 14 and 20, 2003, for the purpose of constructing a vehicular turnaround area. Said turnaround shall be constructed by SPRINGFIELD with materials to be paid for by Robert A. Hathaway, Jr. and Kathleen D. Hathaway. This Motion was unanimously approved.

The portion of said discontinued highway reverting to the abutting landowner is more particularly shown on the above-referenced survey and described therein as follows:

All of that portion of Town Highway #113, Tenney Road, westerly of a line beginning at a point marked at a boundary computation point; thence proceeding N 34° 03' 54" W 50.00 feet to a 3/4" rebar/set at the southwesterly corner of the easement/turnaround. Meaning and intending to discontinue any such highway rights westerly of the aforementioned line as shown on the Gary Rapanotti October 29, 2003 survey, revised November 4, 14 and 20, 2003.
