Gentlemen:

In accordance with Title 19, V.S.A., Section 15, as amended, all the traveled highways in your town were measured in 1971 by Mr. Hart, Road Commissioner, with Mr. Chabot of this office.

The resulting changes in highway mileage are indicated on the enclosed map and are explained on the attached breakdown sheet.

The second breakdown sheet indicates those roads for which we will require copies of the rights-of-way and Certificates of Completion and Opening before they can be added to your town highway mileage.

Also due to remeasurement the length of SA 1 was shortened 0.030 mile while that of SA 2 was increased 0.070 mile.

According to Mr. Hart, the following road is considered to be an old town highway:
