Legislative Act 61 of 1931 authorized the State of Vermont to take over certain highways for a State and/or Federal Aid Highway System.

U. S. Route #7 in the Town of Shelburne was taken into the State Highway System on April 1, 1931 by order of the State Highway Board.

Vermont Route #116 in the Town of Shelburne was taken into the State Highway System on March 29, 1935 by order of the State Highway Board.




