SELECTMEN'S HEARING ON PROPOSED DISCONTINUANCE OF TOWN HIGHWAY 25.
MINUTES: SEPTEMBER 14, 1993
UNAPPROVED

The meeting convened at 7:15 p.m. with Selectmen Gilda Eaton, Norman Brown and Roger Stauss present. There were no public present.

Roger Stauss, Chairman of the select board, read a letter into the meeting from William Parrish requesting the board not discontinue town highway 25, but reclassify the highway to a trail which would require no maintenance from the town but would maintain a right of way.

The clerk reported Robert Fuller, an abutter to town highway 25, had telephoned and expressed concern about the bridge on the town highway and Jean Mishkit visited the clerk's office with the same concern. Neither property owner wanted the responsibility and the resulting liability of owning the bridge, which is what would happen if the town highway was discontinued. The highway right of way would return to the abutting property owners.

Gilda Eaton asked if the bridge on town highway 25 would be removed from the bridge inspection program if the highway was declassified. The clerk said she thought the bridge had been removed from the bridge inventory when the new bridge below it was built.

Roger Stauss made a motion to declassify town highway 25 to a Trail and close the bridge to traffic which was seconded.

Gilda Eaton made a motion for adjournment at 7:30 p.m. which was seconded by Roger Stauss.

Hearing adjourned.



The Selectmen of the Town of Granville received a Town Highway Inspection Remeasurement Form from the Vermont Agency of Transportation, Planning Division dated June 14, 1993 and submitted by Jay Kilton, Road Inventory Chief. Pursuant to Title 19 Section 305, the Form stated Town Highway No. 25, mileage 0.03 of Class 3 Road was not up to Class standards because it was blocked off and closed to all vehicular and foot traffic and needed to be reclassified.

A Hearing, duly warned and advertised, was held on September 14, 1993, the minutes of which are recorded. It is the decision of the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Granville that the Town Highway No. 25, Mileage 0.03 be reclassified from Class three to a Trail.




