

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



2. Old Goshen Road - discussion with visitors

Aaron Coburn, Paula Daukas, Jeff Daukas, and board members participated in discussion of the status of the Old Goshen Rd. The question of the road status was brought to the board's attention at their May 11th meeting. At that meeting, Jonathan Heppell reported that he and Atty. Benjamin Putnam agreed after conducting title searches for buyers, that the segment of road recently named the Old Goshen Rd does not appear to be legally discontinued. The town clerk did not find documentation of discontinuance. Aaron Coburn is purchasing parcel 10-02-49 (Nielsen) and sought clarity about the road classification and driveway options. He referenced the Town Plan to support that it be a town road. Paula Daukas has owned property on the road since 1986, and has been uncertain about the road status since then. All private property owners on the road were contacted before this meeting, and all agreed they would like the road to their properties to be a class 4 town road (via email from Brian Webb, Coburns, Paula Daukas, phone call with Jesse Ethier). The selectboard resolved to add the Old Goshen Rd to the town highway map, as a class 4 road and trail as shown above in motions/votes. Jeff Daukas left the meeting at the close of this discussion (7:30).

Good morning Alison, Tim and Laurie,

I am working on processing the Ripton Mileage Certificate and have reviewed the Selectboard minutes with the certificate and need some additional details. Can you send along the information regarding the legal establishment of the Goshen Road that is mentioned? This would be any of the survey descriptions and Selectboard minutes that might exist for when the road was laid out as a town highway. Based on the minutes, it sounds like this information was discovered in the town records, as well as no information showing discontinuance of this segment of highway.

It looks like TH- Goshen Road may have been altered and a portion relocated at some point in time and the former alignment is being added back to the Mileage Certificate this year. If you have any information regarding when the relocation occurred and documentation of the alteration of the alignment, this would be helpful for us in processing the Mileage Certificate.

If you could send along copies of this information, this will show us that the highways were legally established and aid in us processing the certificate.

Please let me know if you have questions regarding what information I am seeking regarding the addition of this highway and the documents relating to its

establishment.
