

The Select Board certifies the following information regarding Town Road #22: The road, commonly known as Pidgeon Road, was re-established as a town highway in 1888. In 1986 the Board agreed to upgrade the eastern end of the road to meet the standards of a Class 3 road. The upgrade was accomplished shortly thereafter, and the town has continued to maintain the road since that time. The upgrade covers a distance of .25 mile (approximately 1320 feet) westerly from Town Road #8 (Middle Road).

The official highway map indicates that the upgraded portion of Town Road #22 is discontinued. The Board has been unable to locate any documentation to substantiate the "discontinued" designation.

Documents to verify all of the above, as well as a corrected map, are being submitted to the State.
