MEMORANDUM

RE: Discontinuance of Gully Hill Road

The Board of Selectmen have voted unanimously to discontinue .19 miles of Gully Hill Road. This is the portion of road that runs along property currently owned by Kenneth and Susan VonKohorn. Road foreman Tom Estey has stated that this closure makes sense from a road maintenance standpoint. The road crew currently uses an area below where the road will now end to turn their trucks around, and have ceased plowing the .19 mile section as of 2001/2002.

→ This discontinuance was done in accordance with state statutes, including a notification and hearing process. During the process, it was determined by the town's legal counsel (James Carroll) that the portion of Gully Hill Road BEYOND the VonKohorn's which eventually runs into Rounds Road was legally discontinued in October 1929. The Town did not maintain any portion of the old road as a trail, and it has reverted to the property owners as private property. ★
