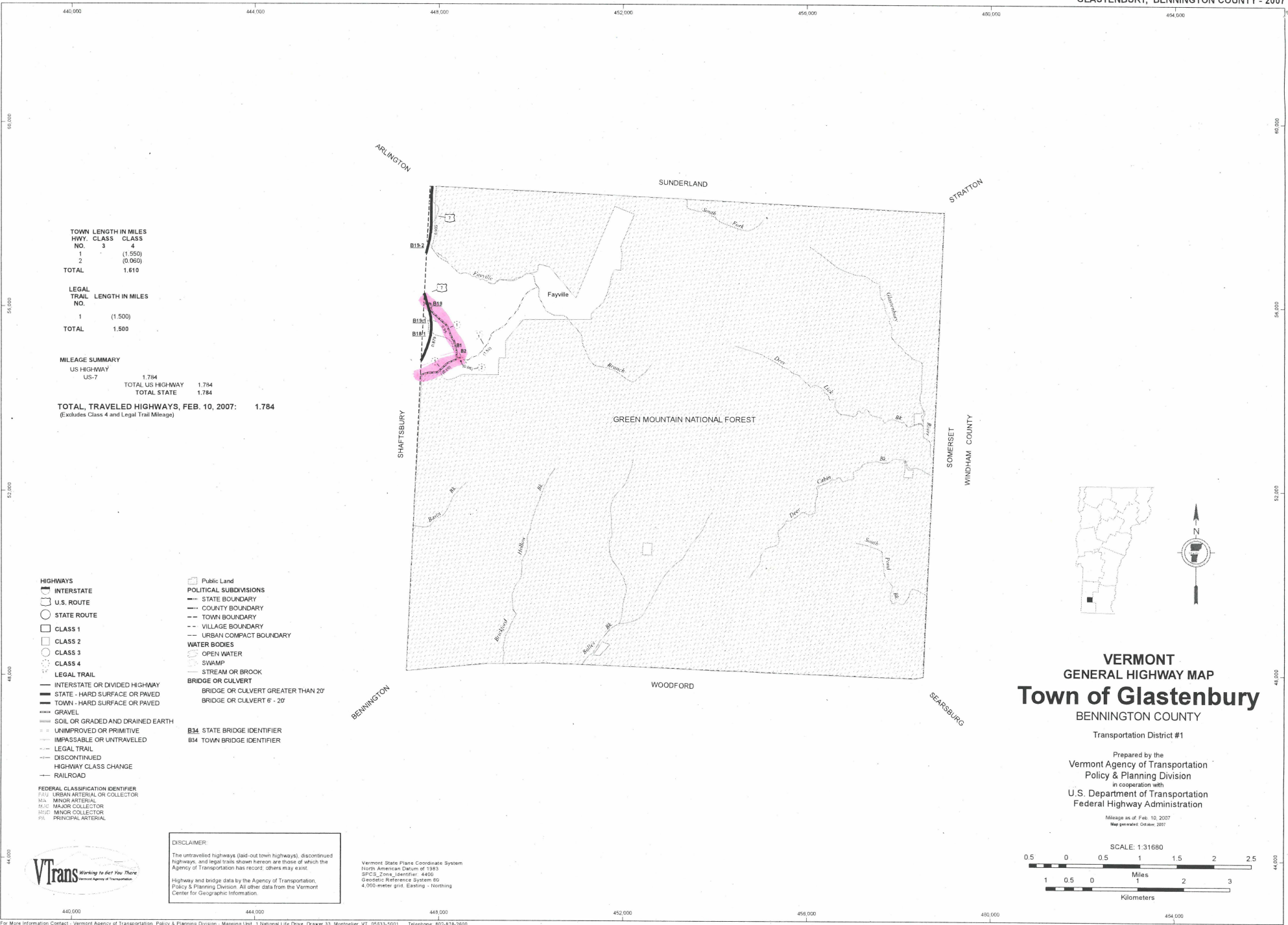
CHAPTER 1. STATE HIGHWAY LAW - § 7. Secretary; powers and duties

(i) The secretary shall assume the powers and duties of a selectboard in highway matters in unorganized towns and gores pursuant to section 16 of this title.

Before I contact Rickey Harrington, I have some questions. Are the roads in a condition to be maintained as Class 3? Are you doing any winter maintenance and keeping the roads passable in the winter? What roads are requested to be upgraded, all of TH-1 and TH-2, or parts? Any info that you can provide would be helpful.

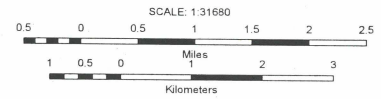

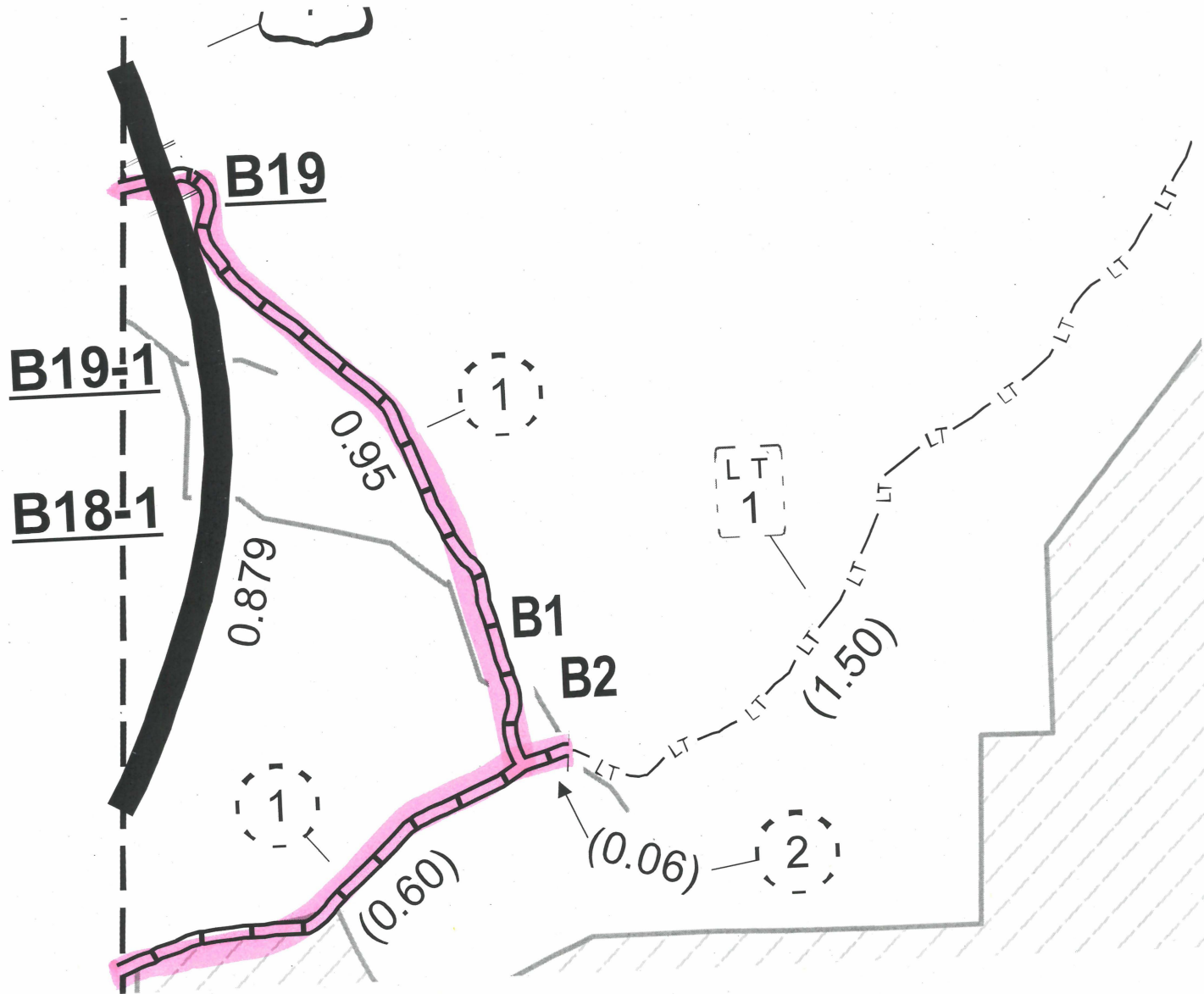
VERMONT

I am aware that by making our road a class 3 road that this will allow us to receive some highway aid and the possibility of grants.

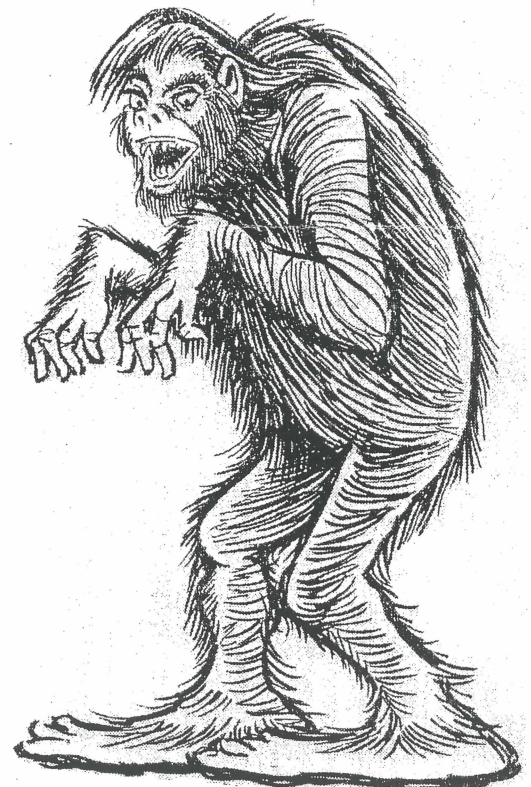
Please let me know if and when this update might happen.
