SELECTBOARD'S FINDINGS AND ORDER OF DISCONTINUANCE

The Selectboard of the Town of Manchester initiated proceedings pursuant to 19 V.S.A. 708 *et seq.* to consider whether Boulder Road should be discontinued.

The Selectboard held an inspection of the Road on October 30, 2007 at 6:00 P.M. and convened a public hearing at 7:00 P.M. to consider testimony on the question of whether to discontinue Boulder Road. The inspection and subsequent inspection were duly noticed to all interested parties as required by 19 V.S.A. § 709. The State of Vermont Department of Parks and Forests was duly noticed as required by 19 V.S.A. § 775 and has declined acceptance of Boulder Road as a public trail.

After consideration of public comments at the hearing, and based upon an inspection of the premises, the Selectboard makes the following findings and conclusions, and issues the following order:

FINDINGS:

1. Boulder Road serves exclusively two privately-owned parcels, owned by Lawrence and Pat Grant and Frank and Sharon Kropa. The Road is approximately 0.1 miles long, unpaved and dead ends at the right-of-way of elevated State Highway Route 7.
2. Boulder Road is not necessary to provide a means of ingress or egress to any other residence, other than the two described above, or public facility.
3. Mr. and Mrs. Grant and Mr. and Mrs. Kropa favor the discontinuance of Boulder Road and agree to assume all maintenance and liabilities.

CONCLUSIONS:

Based on the foregoing Findings, the Selectboard concludes that the public good, necessity and convenience of the residents require that the Road be discontinued. The discontinuance is appropriate based on the Road's location and use.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Boulder Road, beginning at the intersection of East Manchester Road and continuing the entire length to its terminus shall be discontinued. Fee simple title to Boulder Road shall revert to Lawrence and Pat Grant and Frank and Sharon Kropa, effective December 1, 2007. As provided by 19 V.S.A. §775, fee simple title shall be returned to the lots to which it originally belonged, if they can be determined. If not, the fee simple title shall be equally divided between the owners on each side.


