

§ 305. Measurement and inspection

- (a) After reasonable notice to the selectboard, a representative of the agency may measure and inspect the class 1, 2, and 3 town highways in each town to verify the accuracy of the records on file with the agency. Upon request, the selectboard or their designee shall be permitted to accompany the representative of the agency during the measurement and inspection. The agency shall notify the town when any highway, or portion of a highway, does not meet the standards for its assigned class. If the town fails, within one year, to restore the highway or portion of the highway to the accepted standard, or to reclassify, or to discontinue, or develop an acceptable schedule for restoring to the accepted standards, the agency for purposes of apportionment under section 306 of this title shall deduct the affected mileage from that assigned to the town for the particular class of the road in question.
- (b) Annually, on or before February 10, the selectboard shall file with the town clerk a sworn statement of the description and measurements of all class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails then in existence, including any special designation such as a throughway or scenic highway. When class 1, 2, 3, or 4 town highways, trails, or unidentified corridors are accepted, discontinued, or reclassified, a copy of the proceedings shall be filed in the town clerk's office and a copy shall be forwarded to the agency.
- (c) All class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails shall appear on the town highway maps by July 1, 2015.
- (d) At least 45 days prior to first including a town highway or trail that is not clearly observable by physical evidence of its use as a highway or trail and that is legally established prior to February 10, 2006 in the sworn statement required under subsection (b) of this section, the legislative body of the municipality shall provide written notice and an opportunity to be heard at a duly warned meeting of the legislative body to persons owning lands through which a highway or trail passes or abuts.
- (e) The agency shall not accept any change in mileage until the records required to be filed in the town clerk's office by this section are received by the agency. A request by a municipality to the agency for a change in mileage shall include a description of the affected highway or trail, a copy of any surveys of the affected highway or trail, minutes of meetings at which the legislative body took action with respect to the changes, and a current town highway map with the requested deletions and additions sketched on it. A survey shall not be required for class 4 town highways that are legally established prior to February 10, 2006. All records filed with the agency are subject to verification in accordance with subsection (a) of this section.
- (f) The selectboard of any town who are aggrieved by a finding of the agency concerning the measurement, description, or classification of a town highway may appeal to the transportation board by filing a notice of appeal with the executive secretary of the transportation board.
- (g) The agency shall provide each town with a map of all of the highways in that town together with the mileage of each class 1, 2, 3, and 4 highway, as well as each trail, and such other information as the agency deems appropriate.

Certificates of Highway Mileage / Town Highway # 46

Annual review of town highway mileage certificate shows a 0.03 mile stretch of road near the Wheelock/ Sheffield town line that is on the map in error. The state of Vermont recommends that the select board act to remove the road from the certificate. Charles Gilman made to motion to accept the state's recommendation to remove the road since the road is on the map in error. Motion seconded by Walter Smith. Motion passed unanimously.

Consider joining the coalition effort being sponsored by the town of Rutland

The select board began review of a letter from the Town of Rutland to "form a coalition of Vermont communities which will support reasonable legislation to restore local community input to the regulatory process when addressing the issue of Solar Siting in our state."

A second letter, dated January 0, 2015 was received from Renewable Energy Vermont urging that the resolution not be signed.

Given that the select board has not had adequate time to review both letters, Walter Smith made the motion to table the item until the next meeting. Charles Gilman seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Non-binding business to be brought before the board.

Max asked Ed Richardson about the cleanliness of the Town Hall. Coordinators of regular activities clean and mop after the event is over. There has been a communication breakdown over when the hall has been rented and when the hall was inspected last. Ed needs to know if there is a problem with the cleaning and he will arrange for the hall to be cleaned.

The drive shaft on the new town truck came apart due to a faulty casting, resulting in a leaking radiator. Cost is approximately \$5,000.00 to fix the truck. Max was urged by the other members of the board to pursue payment from the people who installed the truck body. Repairs should not come under the truck's warranty.

Hi Max,

Yes, those documents would definitely help, assuming they refer to a public right of way (town highway).

Because it can sometimes be challenging to associate legal descriptions with specific parcels, could you "label" the documents with some parcel identifier that corresponds with your parcel data? Maybe the MAPCODE, or another field with unique values other than the FID which can change when copied to another dataset. We wouldn't necessarily need all of the relevant descriptions, just enough to clearly show that more than one property's description clearly indicates

that Ham's Camp Rd is public. Ideally, the description for the property associated with 11 Ham's Camp road will describe a public right of way that corresponds to the layout of Ham's Camp road, but have no mention of a public right of way along the driveway that currently leads to the house.

Selectboard Chair Amos,

The VTrans Mapping Section has historically shown the class 4 portion of TH-20 (Sulfur Spring Rd) extending into Sheffield (as Sheffield TH-46, formerly part of Sheffield TH-27 before the construction of I-91). With new information regarding location of the Sheffield-Wolcott town boundary, it has become apparent that the portion of this class 4 town highway south of I-91, that was believed to be in Sheffield, is actually in Wolcott. It is therefore appropriate that the 0.03 mi removed from Sheffield TH-46 be added to Wolcott TH-20. Please see the attached maps to see the updated linework for TH-20 (red and blue lines) superimposed on the original linework, imagery, parcel data, and a highway plan for I-91.

It is my understanding that Sheffield (cc'd) has discontinued TH-46 (with zero length) for clarity. Assuming that we can process the Sheffield change, we recommend that that 0.03 mi be added to Wolcott class 4 TH-20 on the 2016 Certificate of Highway Mileage. Because this is a class 4 change, it will not affect funding from the State for class 3 town highways. Unless you have additional information that I am aware of, I will pre-load this change onto the 2016 Certificate before mailing it to you on January 2, 2016.

Hello Max,

I've taken a closer look at the Sheffield parcel data provided by Judy Bond, and reviewed some discrepancies that she mentioned to Johnathan Croft earlier this year. I will be updating our road centerline data so that the following class 4 town highways match the parcel dataset, as suggested by: TH-21, TH-22, TH-23, TH-45, and TH-48. There is a discontinued legal trail that connects with TH-45 on historic town highway maps, so I'm assuming that it should also be shifted so that it still intersects TH-45.

The VTrans Mapping Section will be sending out the 2016 Certificate of Highway Mileage in early January. Do you want me to pre-load the "removal" of TH-46 onto the Certificate, as described in my previous email to you (see below)? If so, just let me know within the next couple weeks.

Regarding TH-31, it resembles a driveway to #11 Ham's Camp Rd in our records (and in the Sheffield parcel data). There is, however, a "private" road that E911 refers to as Ham's Camp Rd intersecting TH-30 at the same location as TH-31, and Ham's Camp Rd does extend into Wheelock. Is it possible that the Town Highway Map, and the Sheffield parcel data both show TH-31 incorrectly, and that TH-31 should be Ham's Camp Rd instead? You have referred to TH-31 as Ham's Camp Rd in previous correspondence, but I didn't want to simply assume that there had been a switch because the parcel data may reflect some additional information that the Mapping Section is unaware of. The attached map shows the parcel data along with both possible interpretations of Ham's Camp Rd.



Hello Angus, Jonathan and Sara,

We just did the final delivery of the parcel map for Wheelock, and as you know, we did the map for Sheffield in 2013.

Both towns had major discrepancies for the state mapped locations of several of their class 4 roads relative to the true locations.

We walked the roads with a GPS and created a centerline to offset for the right of way. The road centerlines are included in the file AllLines for each town.

In Sheffield, please review the locations of the class 4 roads relative to our parcel map. As some (TH 22, 24, 48) were contentious, we walked them with Max Aldrich, Sheffield selectboard. These roads have recreational use and/or camps. We also walked LT 2, which goes through the wind farm with Max. The alignment is north of the state version. On the east side, there is a private road paralleling the town alignment of the road, which is unusable. The center portion of LT 2 road has no use.

TH 21 is east of the alignment on the AOT map. See Sheffield_Fieldmap_1963 in the town map archives. There are no houses, camps or recreational use on this road once past the last house on the east side or beyond the first 1/4 mile or so on the south side.

TH 45, which serves several lots, is also not in the correct location.

In Wheelock, the AOT map is closer to the real alignments of Piperville Road (TH 35 and LT 6) Kenniston Hill (LT 5) and Dunn Mountain Road (LT 4), but both were quite different in places. Kenniston Road has camps along much of its length, and all 3 roads have considerable recreational ATV use.

From this plat and review of the 56 of 155 of the Interstate 91 project I-91-3(14), it appears that TH-20 in Wheelock ends at the boundary of the Interstate right of way and the town line. The former highway in Sheffield was taken in the building of the I-91 and cut this through highway. Only a small triangle section of town highway right of way is shown as a remnant. There are several issues that I can see regrding TH-46 on the Town Highway Map for Sheffield, first is the location of the Sheffield – Wheelock Town Line. We are currently showing the town line too far to the west and we need to make the necessary adjustments. Based on information provided and the documentation for the Interstate plans, we should be able to make this adjustment. The second issue relates to the alignment that we have for TH-46. Since it appears to only be a small triangle of town highway right of way within Sheffield, we need to more accurately depict this.

This might be a case where there is really no mileage of centerline still existing Sheffield, as the centerline leaves Wheelock and enters directly into the right of way of the Interstate in Sheffield. It

might make sense to discontinue the section of TH-46 in Sheffield, based on weighing all the information in the Town Records.

Here is a screen shot of the end of Sulphur Spgs road over the 1999 orthophoto.

The old alignment is faintly visible continuing beyond the sharp turn to the left.

That turn appears on the ground to be the driveway to the Sheffield houses, not an old town road. The continuation of the alignment is faintly visible when standing at the end of the road, but we did not walk it.

Note that the townline is different than the VCGI/VTrans line. It was generated by looking at the

surveys along the Sheffield/Wheelock boundary and clues visible on the orthophotos. After it has been
