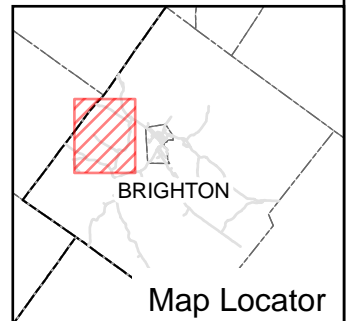
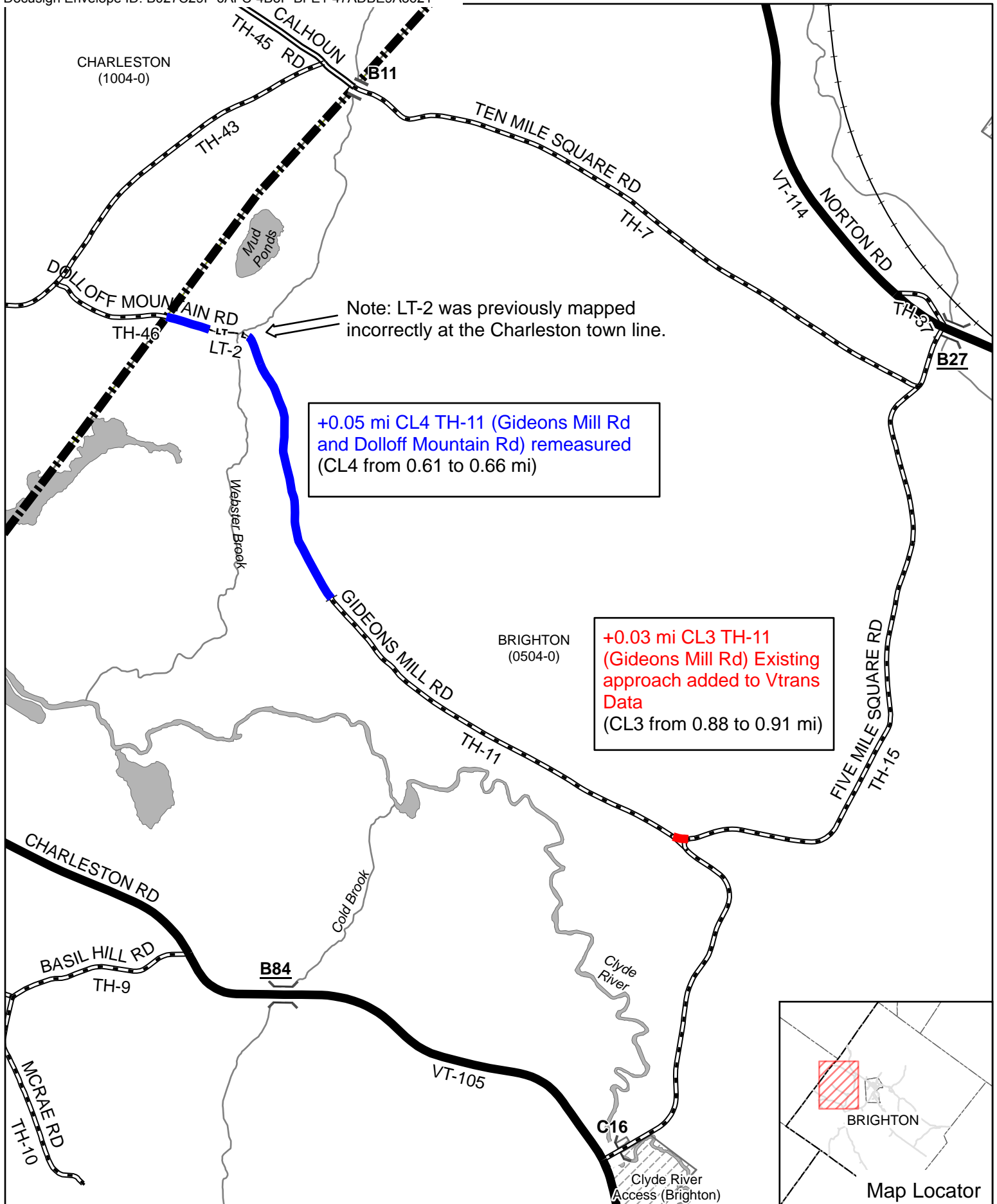

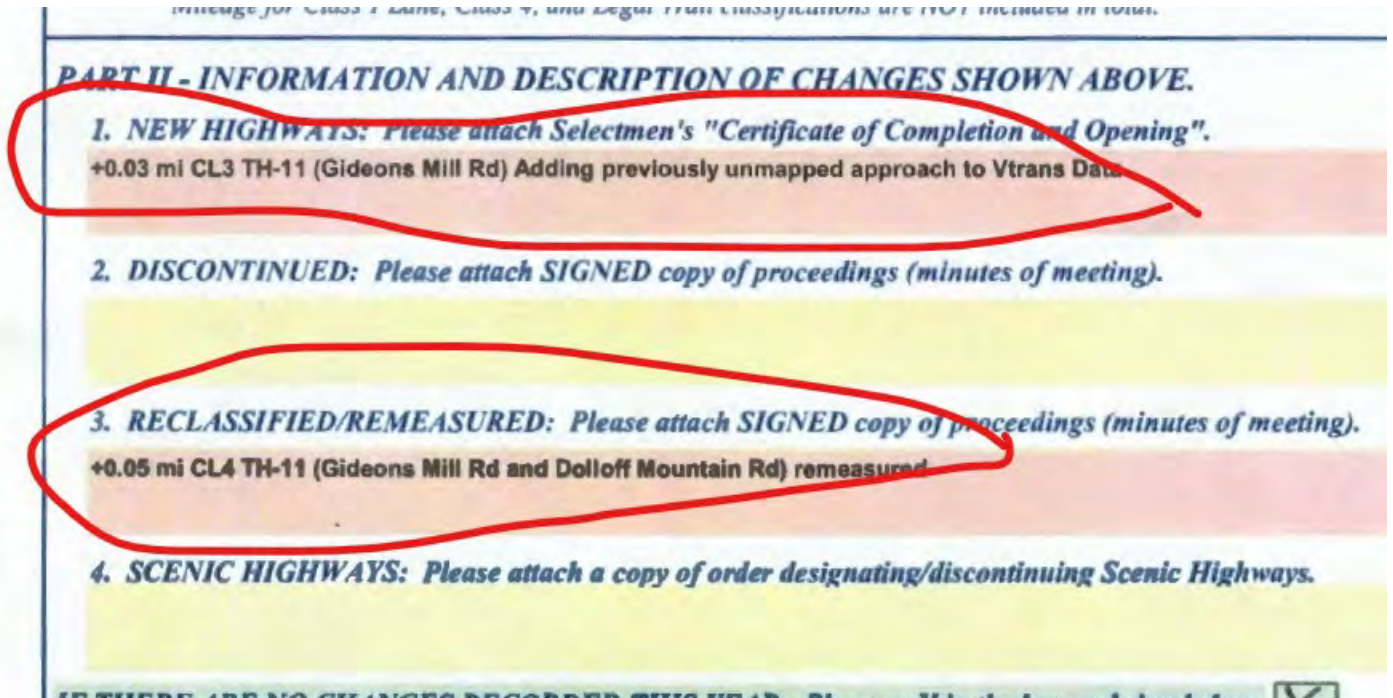

Good afternoon Joel,

I just found a message from 12/11/2024 in my email drafts folder (see message pasted below, and this email's attachments), and realized that I never sent it to you because I didn't have your correct email address in December, so I ended up speaking with Andy Martin (and later with you) by phone about TH-11.

Thanks to you and Andy, I was able to confirm the correct location of Legal Trail 2 (see first attachment), the location of the town line with Charleston (see second attachment), and where TH-11 becomes class 4 (at the driveway of #870 Gideons Mill Rd). I also spoke with both of you about the second approach to Gideons Mill Rd from Five Mile Square Rd (not mentioned in the message below, but see third attachment). Although you and Andy already provided me with all the answers I needed, I figured I'd send you this belated email now anyway, as it documents relevant details about the preloaded changes on Brighton's 2025 Mileage Certificate.

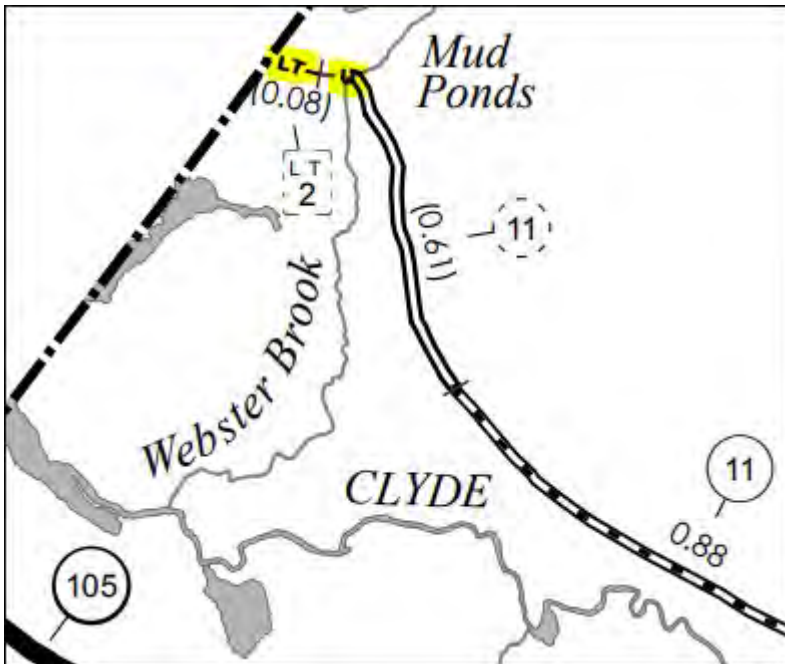

The original unsent message:

Good afternoon Joel,

I wanted to let you know that we found (and corrected) an error on the Brighton Town Highway Map.

The first image below is an excerpt from current Brighton Town Highway Map (2015) highlighting how we had been mapping LT-2 as reaching the town line, and the roadway near Webster Brook as an untraveled portion of TH-11. However, the documentation from the 1993 reclassification indicates that the legal trail is actually supposed to cross Webster Brook.



An excerpt from 1993 reclassification documentation describing the legal trail:

3. Town Highway #11: from Webster Brook easterly 100 feet becomes legal trail; from Webster Brook westerly up to the currently travelled portion of T.H. #11 becomes trail, a distance of 100 yards.

Our updated data is visible in the PDF map attached to this email.

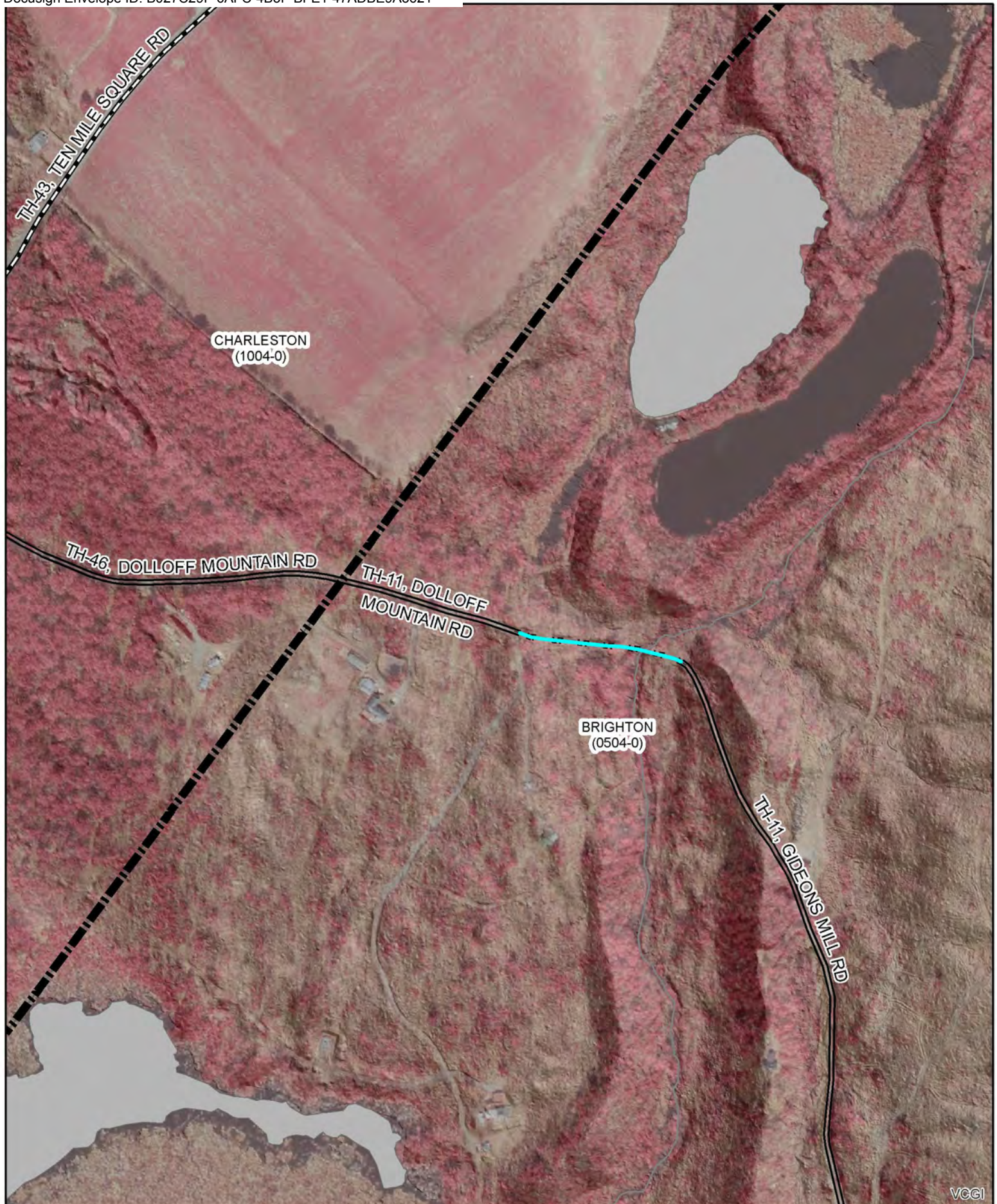
This update to our records does not affect LT-2 mileage, only how it is shown on the map. The mileage of LT-2 does not need to be modified because our mapping software indicates that LT-2 is 0.08 mi long which matches our records, the measure obtained using our mapping software, and the documented description (as $100' + 100 \text{ yards} = 400' = 0.08$ when rounded to the nearest 0.01 mi).

Before I can confirm whether the length CL4 TH-11 mileage matches our records (0.61 mi as shown on the Town Highway Map and in the first image above), I need to be sure that I know exactly where the CL4 portion of TH-11 begins, and where Dolloff Mountain Rd crosses the town line. Is there someone in Brighton who can confirm whether the locations I've indicated in the images below are correct?

If those are the correct locations of the town line and the beginning of CL4 TH-11, then our mapping software indicates the length of CL4 TH-11 should be approximately 0.09 mi (the portion extending to the town line, called Dolloff Mountain Rd) plus 0.57 mi (the portion called Gideons Mill Rd, between Webster Brook and TH-15 Five Mile Square Rd), which totals 0.66 mi instead of the 0.61 mi that is currently shown on the map.
