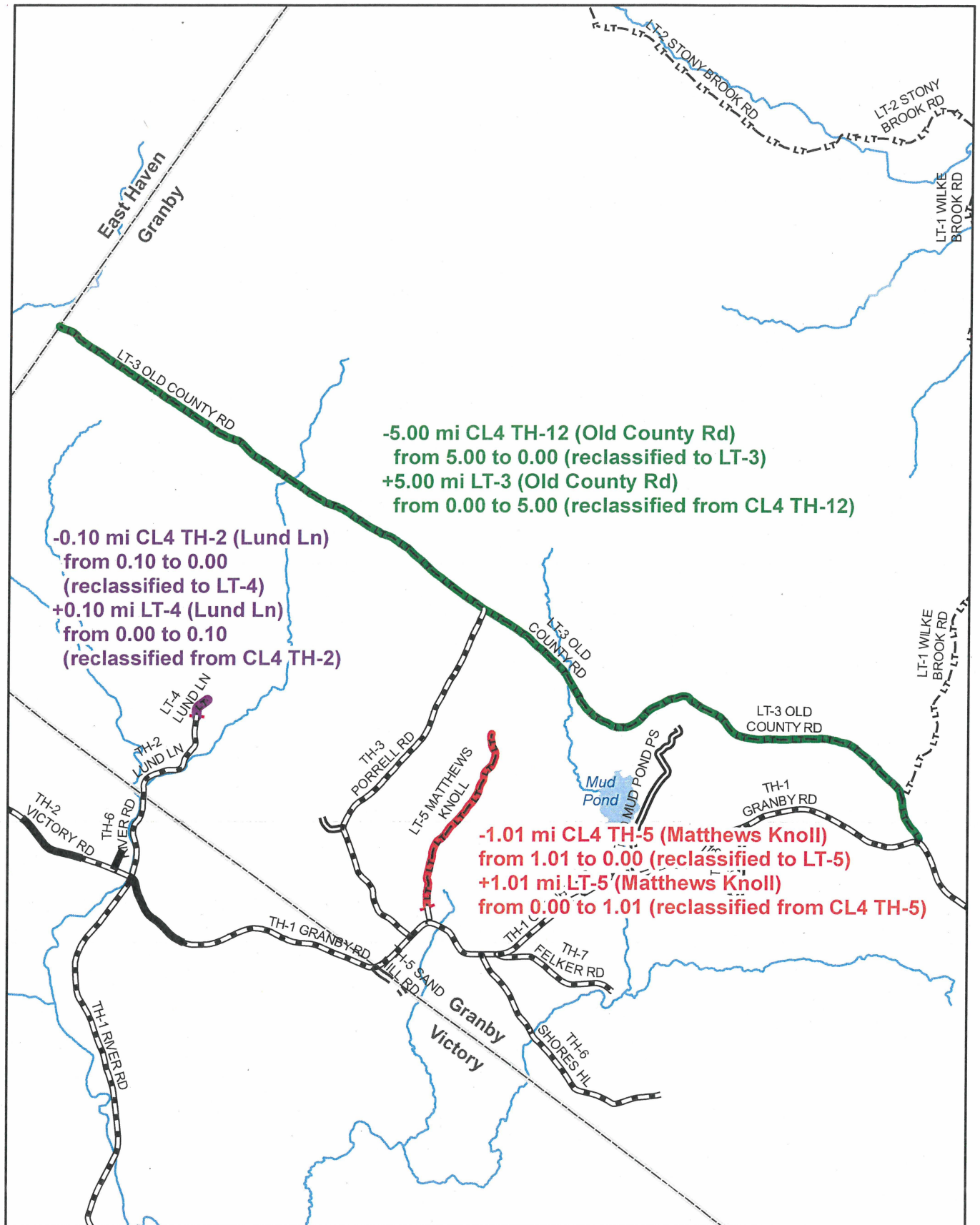

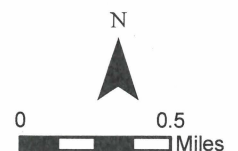

Granby Selectboard Meeting Minutes
July 25, 2018
Granby Town Office

Present: Larry Brown, Reginald Bunnell and Robert Peters-selectmen; Nellie Noble-Town Clerk
Called to order at 7:14 p.m. by Chairman Robert Peters

Agenda: To vote on the reclassification of three roads from class 4 to legal trails.

First road is the Old County Road #12. Reg Bunnell made motion to reclassify it from class 4 to legal trail. Seconded by Larry Brown. Motion passed 3-0

Second road is a section of Lund Lane #2. Reg Bunnell made motion to reclassify it from class 4 to legal trail. Seconded by Larry Brown. Motion passed 3-0

Third road is a section of Matthews Knoll #5. Robert said that he feels this road should stay as it is. Reg Bunnell made motion to reclassify it from class 4 to legal trail. Seconded by Larry Brown. Voted as: Larry Brown-yes, Robert Peters-no, Reg Bunnell-yes. Motion passed 2-0

Larry asked when this goes into effect and Nellie said she thought immediately but she will check with VT Agency of Transportation and she has some forms, etc to fill out and minutes to type up. It gets submitted to VT Agency of Transportation for their approval and then it technically goes into effect...

July 25, 2018
Granby Town Hall
Re: Reclassification of class 4 roads to Legal Trails

Hearing called to order at 6:30 pm by Selectboard Chairman Robert Peters.

Present: Selectboard-Robert Peters (also the road foreman), Reginald Bunnell, Larry Brown; Town Clerk/Treasurer-Nellie Noble; Interested parties- Rich Carbonetti representing LIADSA Investments II, Cheryl Shores Mitchell, Bonnie Sult, Rob Roy, Barb & John Irwin, Ian Irwin, and Betty Brown.

Nellie Noble arrived at town hall approximately 6:15 and distributed copies of the town highway map with the three roads to be discussed highlighted. No one wished to go and do a site visit to the exact locations.

Following is questions and responses.

Robert: explained main reason for the Selectmen wanting to do the reclassification is because of the new state mandates saying that all Class 4 roads will have to be brought up to state standards and where before we were not required to do certain maintenance and upkeep, now we will have to.

LIADSA: Why not just throw them all up instead of having public access to them. He is more interested in the Old County Road section.

Robert: To keep access for all property owners so they have a legal right of way

John Irwin: As far as recreation on them he does not want recreation available as far as ATV's and Snow machines.

Robert: Heard that any unplowed class 4 road can be open to snow machines in VT.

Nellie: I have not heard anything about this.

Reg: He is on the Essex County VAST committee and any new trails have to be approved first and get landowners permission

Larry: The Selectmen don't have any plan to open them up to ATVs or Snow machines

LIADSA: So this means the town would not be liable for any maintenance

Sherri: So what is the main purpose of doing this, why not just throw them up.

Robert: We cannot take comments on throwing up any of these roads at this hearing as it was not warned to do so. Within six years we will HAVE to start doing maintenance to those class 4 roads

Sherri: There is a copy of the survey recorded in the town records and a copy is in the history book

LIADSA: Rich said a legal trail is a legal right of way

Irwin's: Would this change the way that I can use my section of the road and he was told no.

Bonnie: At one time there was a sign put up by her property that said County Road TH#12 and it caused a lot of problems for those property owners near that as vehicles were trying to go thru and messed the road up. The sign was taken down after that.

Selectboard: Changing this to a legal trail will not make it available to motorized vehicles. Some roads can have gates put across and posted that they are closed for certain dates to protect the roads like in early spring.

Class 2 & 3 Granby Roads are the only ones on the town ordinance that were ever opened to ATV's and Snowmacinces. Class 4 were never listed.

Robert: Like right now there are two culverts on road #5 that the state survey says will need to be fixed/replaced and will be very costly to the tax payers. There are no state aid money for class 4 rows. This road should not be thrown up as it is the only legal access for a number of land owners.

No further comments so hearing closed at 7:13 and was immediately followed by the Special Selectboard Meeting to vote on the reclassification.

Persons owning or interested in lands through which the proposed reclassification of all class 4 roads to legal trails that may pass or abut, are hereby warned of a public hearing to be held by the Selectboard of the Town of Granby to consider the reclassification of our class 4 roads. Pursuant to 19 V.S.A. § 709, the proceedings will commence with an examination of the premises, convening at 9005 Granby Road promptly at 6:25 pm. No testimony shall be accepted at the site visit. Immediately following the examination of the premises, the Selectboard of the Town of Granby will meet at the Granby Town Hall to receive testimony from any interested parties. The Selectboard shall issue a written decision within 60 days of the hearing.

Time of Hearing: 6:30 pm




Description of Highways: The proposed reclassification is for the following Class 4 highways.



3. Section of TH #5 on town highway map consisting of 1.01 miles starting at approximately 79 Matthews Knoll.


