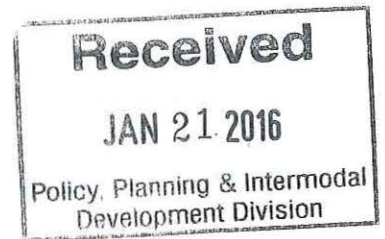

**Vermont Statutes Annotated**  
**19 V.S.A. § 305. Measurement and inspection**



**§ 305. Measurement and inspection**

(a) After reasonable notice to the selectboard, a representative of the agency may measure and inspect the class 1, 2, and 3 town highways in each town to verify the accuracy of the records on file with the agency. Upon request, the selectboard or their designee shall be permitted to accompany the representative of the agency during the measurement and inspection. The agency shall notify the town when any highway, or portion of a highway, does not meet the standards for its assigned class. If the town fails, within one year, to restore the highway or portion of the highway to the accepted standard, or to reclassify, or to discontinue, or develop an acceptable schedule for restoring to the accepted standards, the agency for purposes of apportionment under section 306 of this title shall deduct the affected mileage from that assigned to the town for the particular class of the road in question.

(b) Annually, on or before February 10, the selectboard shall file with the town clerk a sworn statement of the description and measurements of all class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails then in existence, including any special designation such as a throughway or scenic highway. When class 1, 2, 3, or 4 town highways, trails, or unidentified corridors are accepted, discontinued, or reclassified, a copy of the proceedings shall be filed in the town clerk's office and a copy shall be forwarded to the agency.

(c) All class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails shall appear on the town highway maps by July 1, 2015.

(d) At least 45 days prior to first including a town highway or trail that is not clearly observable by physical evidence of its use as a highway or trail and that is legally established prior to February 10, 2006 in the sworn statement required under subsection (b) of this section, the legislative body of the municipality shall provide written notice and an opportunity to be heard at a duly warned meeting of the legislative body to persons owning lands through which a highway or trail passes or abuts.

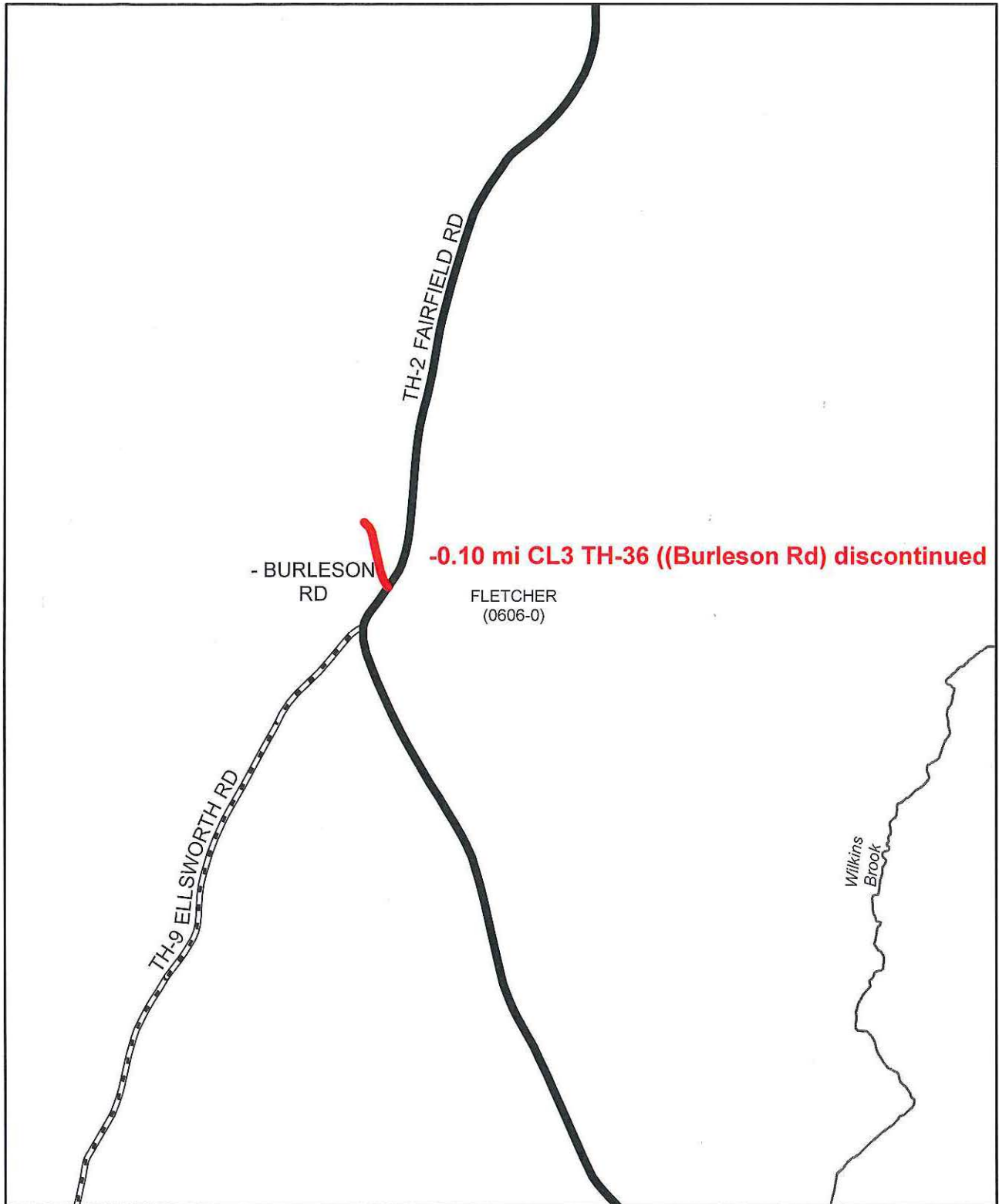
(e) The agency shall not accept any change in mileage until the records required to be filed in the town clerk's office by this section are received by the agency. A request by a municipality to the agency for a change in mileage shall include a description of the affected highway or trail, a copy of any surveys of the affected highway or trail, minutes of meetings at which the legislative body took action with respect to the changes, and a current town highway map with the requested deletions and additions sketched on it. A survey shall not be required for class 4 town highways that are legally established prior to February 10, 2006. All records filed with the agency are subject to verification in accordance with subsection (a) of this section.

(f) The selectboard of any town who are aggrieved by a finding of the agency concerning the measurement, description, or classification of a town highway may appeal to the transportation board by filing a notice of appeal with the executive secretary of the transportation board.

(g) The agency shall provide each town with a map of all of the highways in that town together with the mileage of each class 1, 2, 3, and 4 highway, as well as each trail, and such other information as the agency deems appropriate

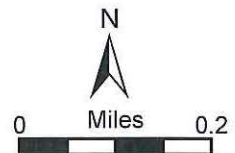

Discontinuance of Town Highway 36, Burleson Road, a Class III Town Highway

On May 4, 2015, The Town of Fletcher Select Board moved to initiate a discontinuance of Burleson Road, a Class III Town Highway described as follows:

Burleson Road (Hwy #36) is off of Fairfield Road, about 200 feet north of the Ellsworth Road intersection. The road is approximately 0.1 miles in length.

Attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is the Minutes of the Select Board meeting held on May 4, 2015.

On July 6, 2015, the Select Board set a date of August 10 at 7pm as the date to inspect Burleson Road with hearing to follow. (Attached hereto as Exhibit 2 is the minutes of the Select Board meeting held on July 6, 2015.

On July 8, 2015 a certified letter regarding discontinuance of Burleson Road was sent to persons owning or abutting lands affected. The certified letter contained notice of the site visit and hearing. (Attached hereto as Exhibit 3 is the Certificate of Service).

On July 10, 2015 Notice of Pubic Hearing on Discontinuance of Burleson Road was published in the St. Albans Messenger and on July 16, 2015 it was published in The Transcript. (Attached hereto as exhibit 4 is a copy of the newspaper publication).

On July 8, 2015, the Notice of Public Hearing on Discontinuance of Burleson Road was posted and received by the Fletcher Planning Commission. The Notice was posted in the Town Clerk's office. (Attached hereto as Exhibit 5 is Notice of Public Hearing with Town Clerk's certification).

On August 10, 2015, the Town of Fletcher Select Board conducted a site visit for inspection of Burleson Road and held a public hearing at 7:30pm at the Town Offices. The Select Board set a deadline of August 24 for the submission of any additional comments or written information.

Based on the examination of Burleson Road, the information provided at the public hearing, and the written information provided after the hearing, the Town of Fletcher Select Board determined that Burleson Road, a Class III Town Highway, should be discontinued. The discontinued Class III Highway known and designated as Burleson Road is shown and laid down on a plan of land entitled Burleson Road Improvements T.H. #36 done by Summit Engineering

May 4, 2015 7pm

Select Board members present were Jon Bondy, Todd Pritsky, Sue Ferguson, Terry Riggs and Annette Kalinoski. Also attending was Mary Jane Featherstone and Elaine Sweet.

Road Report: Wright Road was opened about April 10. The beaver dam below Metcalf Pond went out and no damage was done below the dam. The beavers have rebuilt and the water level is almost back to its previous level. We plan to use the Better Back Road grant to work on School Road. Terry working with the State on the Fairfax Rd culvert permit. We still plan to start work on the culvert in July.

Burleson Road: We reviewed a letter from Chad Bonanni (town attorney) titled Discontinuance of Class IV Road, dated March 24, 2015. The letter explains that we start the proceedings with a Motion of Discontinuance followed by a site visit. **A motion was made to start discontinuance proceedings on Burleson Rd (Hwy #36). All agreed.** A site visit is planned for June 15 at 5:30pm.

New Town Office: We discussed loan options for the new town office and will continue to discuss these options with local experts. We can secure a construction loan while we evaluate the bank's offer. We are meeting with the Rebecca, the architect, before each scheduled select board meeting. A summary of that meeting is attached to these minutes.

We also approved the renewal of the dental plan for current employees.

The meeting was closed for executive session at 7:45 and reopened 8:35. No action was taken during this session.

The meeting adjourned at 8:40. Our next meeting will be May 18, 2015 at 7pm.

Road Report: We received the estimate for repair on the 95 Mack; our insurance will cover the cost.

The Listers requested a raise in their hourly rate. Sue will look into what other towns our size pay and come back with a suggestion.

Burleson Road: The site visit on July 20 will have to be delayed because we did not send out the notices correctly. **New notices will be sent and the new site visit is set for August 10 at 7pm, with the hearing to follow at the town office. Annette will draft the new letter.**

Elaine reviewed the year-end budget. The Listers are almost done with the updates to the Grand List. We should be able to set the new tax rate on Monday, July 13.

We've had another complaint filed against the McGillises' huskies. The family will be charged another fee and the State Police have been notified. Annette will write the fee notice.

We are updating our dog ordinance to include fees and impoundment for malicious dogs, which are dogs that attack or harass other domestic animals. Our current ordinance only applies dogs that run at large and vicious dogs, which are dogs that bite or snap at people. We will have the VLTC review the new ordinance to make sure it is within State law.

Brad has declined to use the town's health care plan. The board voted to add 80% of the allowed health care dollars to Brad's salary so he can purchase his own plan.

The board discussed the interim town clerk position. Only one person has applied since the notice was place in the Fletcher Newsletter.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00. Our next meeting will be July 20, 2015 at 7pm.
