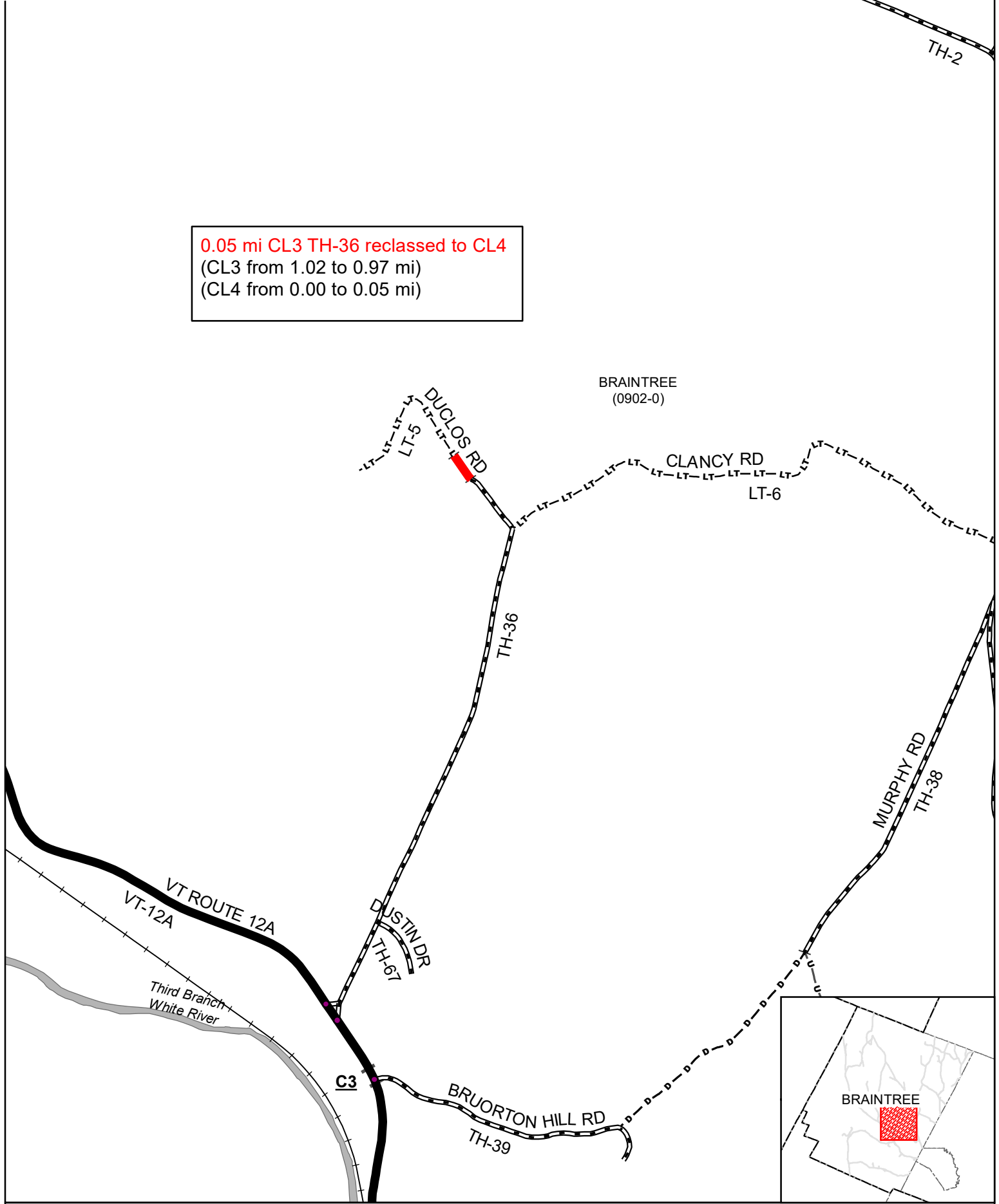

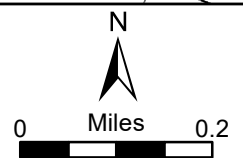

Road Reclassification Report of Findings and Order  
for  
Duclos Rd, Town Highway 36  
December 5, 2023

On October 3, 2023 the Braintree Selectboard decided to schedule a site visit and hearing to consider reclassifying Duclos Rd from a Class 3 to a Class 4 road from the point where the legal trail begins to the existing culvert at the plow truck turn around beyond 948 Duclos Rd. Notices were sent to potentially impacted landowners on October 6, 2023 in accordance with 19 V.S.A. Section 709.


The site visit and hearing was held in accordance with 19 V.S.A. Section 710 on November 7 at 5:15:pm. The minutes from the hearing are attached to this Order, as well as copies of written comments received.

After examining the premises and hearing all interested parties, the selectboard judges that the public good, necessity, and convenience of the inhabitants of the municipality require the highway to be reclassified from a Class 3 road to a Class 4 road from the point where the legal trail begins to the existing culvert at the plow truck turn around beyond 948 Duclos Rd.
