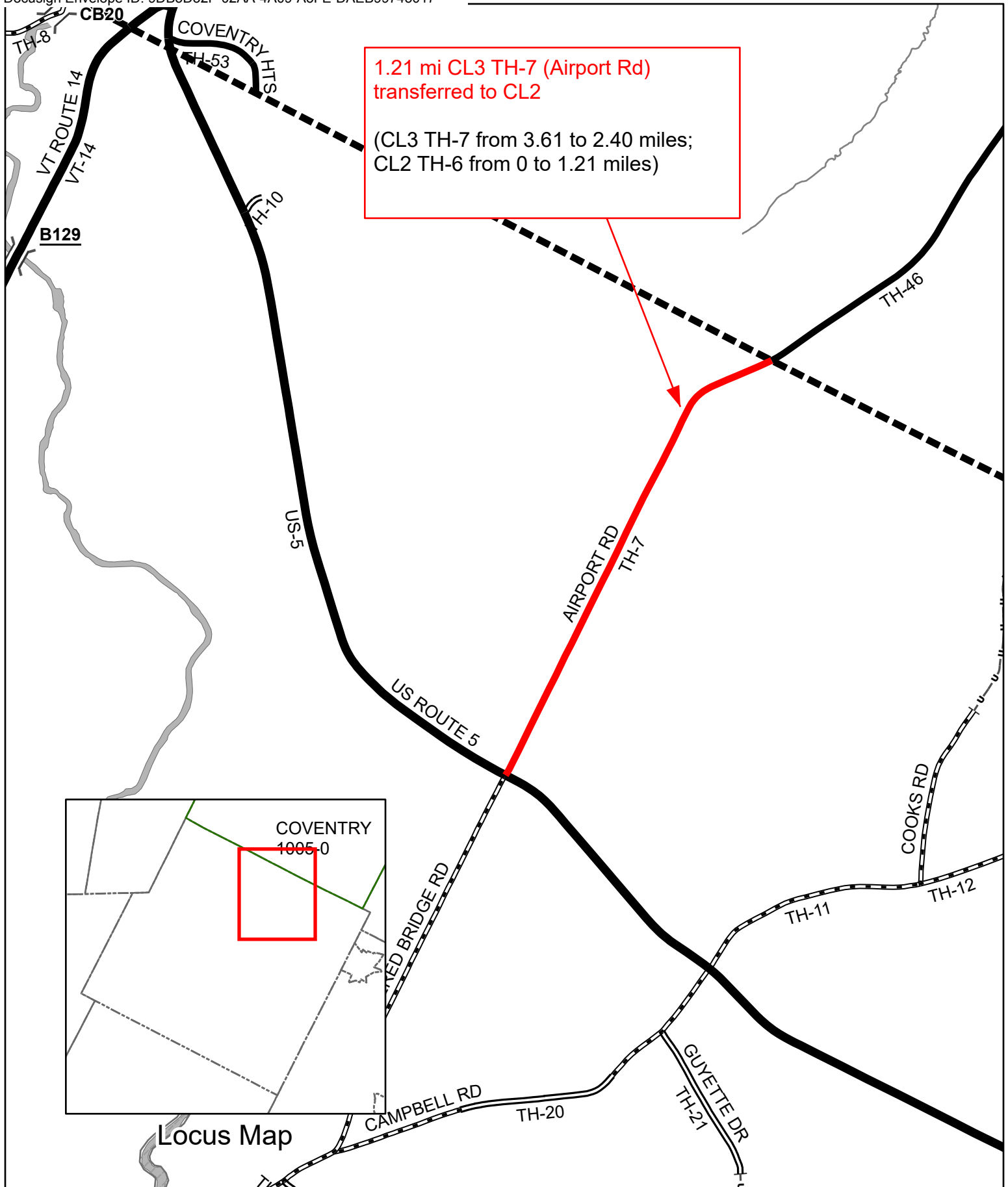

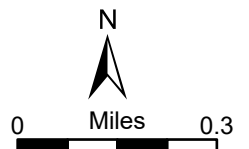



This transfer to the Class 2 Town Highway system is **recommended** for Airport Road in Irasburg and Coventry, making the connection between US-5 and existing class 2 town highway. The 25% guideline for class 2 is exceeded but has been allowed in cases of multiple towns with one town within the 25% threshold. Airport Road provides integration to the highway system and an alternate route during flooding events.

## **RE: Formal Request for reclassification of Airport Road from class 3 to class 2**

The Town of Irasburg is requesting the reclassification of Airport Road from a class 3 to a class 2 road. We believe this road meets all the criteria required in the orange book to be a class 2 road. The Town of Irasburg looks forward to working with the district 9 office to determine if our reclassification request can be met.

## **RE: Municipal Input support Reclassification**

- Airport road is a class 3 road in the Town of Irasburg that begins on Route 58 class 1 highway and continues in a northerly direction 1.2 miles to the Coventry town line.
- Airport road is currently a gravel road with a high volume of traffic. Doug Morton from Northeast Vermont Development Association (NVDA) performed the required traffic AADT and the count averaged 631 vehicles per day.
- Some of the high traffic volume is due to an extra-large dairy farm approximately  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile north of Route 58.
- Airport road also provides a Route for commuters from Coventry.
- Route 58 through the Village of Coventry is prone to flooding and Airport Road gives an alternate route for commuters as well as commercial truck traffic to

Casella Waste Systems. Recent flooding this summer sent all route 58 traffic to Newport in that direction.

- Airport road is a 3 rod (49.5feet) right of way road according to the Vermont Statutes Annotated under Title 19: Highways. It has an average width from shoulder to shoulder of 26-28 feet depending on location.

Because of these reasons we strongly believe that Airport Road should have its classifications changed from a class 3 to a class 2 town road.
