The attached listing can be updated and mailed to this department or you can access and update the information directly on online by creating your own ID and password, following the instructions provided.

- 1. Any municipality which has enacted special weight limits which are other than state legal limits for highways or bridges within its jurisdiction shall provide a complete listing of the limitations with the Department of Motor Vehicles no later than February 10th of each year. If entering the information on line, it must be updated prior to March 30th of the posting year. The name, title, mailing address, and telephone number of the principal person or persons responsible for issuing the local permit, along with a copy of the Town Ordinance, must also be on file with this department to properly post the highway. The information on file shall contain concise information for each highway and bridge that is being weight restricted, the restricted weight and the dates the restrictions apply. Highways and bridges not requiring a special weight restriction should not be included in the listing.
- 2. Any special municipal weight limits on highways or bridges shall be unenforceable unless they are on file with the Department of Motor Vehicles within three working days of the date of posting. It shall be the responsibility of the municipality to keep records documenting the time and date a highway or bridge is posted, and to keep current restrictions on file with this department.

3. State Limits are:

- a. Sixteen thousand pounds upon any bridge with a wooden floor, wooden subfloor or wood stringers on a class 3 or 4 town highway or twenty thousand pounds on a bridge with a wood floor, wood subfloor or wood stringers on a class 1 or 2 town highway unless otherwise posted by the selectmen of such town.
- b. Twenty-four thousand pounds upon a class 2, 3 or 4 town highway with other than a wood floor, in any town, incorporated village or city.
- c. No vehicle may exceed a gross weight in excess of eighty thousand pounds unless the operator or owner of the vehicle has complied with the provisions of Title 23 section §1400.
- 4. This information must be filed by February 10th of each year and submitted to the address indicated above, Attention: Commercial Vehicle Operations or updated on line prior to March 30th of the posting year.
