



Hello Mari,

Our goal is to have the correct length of Crosset Hill in our records. The change in mileage is correcting a past mistake by VTrans, and has nothing to do with any changes made to Crossett Hill. The mileage shown on the town highway map is incorrect, and has likely always been

incorrect. We discovered the discrepancy when the VTrans Mapping Section measured the road in 1989 (accompanied by Selectperson Robert Magee Jr and Road Commissioner David Guenneutla) when the length of Crossett Hill found to be only 3.51 mi long, not 3.78 mi long which is the measure in the VTrans records. In order to double-check the length of the road, I also used our mapping software to calculate the length of the road that is clearly visible in imagery, and the length was calculated to be 3.52 mi.

Let me know if you want additional details about how we determined the length of Crossett Hill. I would also be willing to explain the details to your road commissioner.

I do not see how the 600 foot difference = .26 miles(1372"9.6)? This is over double the length referenced (3.78 less 3.52)

Hello Mari,

Maybe it would be easier to speak by phone? I am free until 11 am this morning, and this afternoon after 3:30 pm.

The change in mileage has nothing to do with the adjustment to Crossett Hill (TH-4) that we made in 2021. After making that adjustment and preparing the 2021 map, I noticed that the mileage we (VTrans Mapping) had on record for TH-4 has been incorrect for years. The documentation that I attached to the previous email (which I can explain in more detail on the phone) indicates that VTrans was aware of the correct measure back in 1989, but possibly didn't notice (or forgot to deal with) the discrepancy. I only noticed the discrepancy because I couldn't get the numbers to add up correctly when I updated the 2021 map.

I am forwarding (see below) an email to you that I sent to Maureen Harvey on December 20 <sup>th</sup> that describes what we did. The change in mileage for TH-4 (Crossett Hill) we added to your 2022 Mileage Certificate only reflects a remeasurement to correct an error in our records. The					

"official" mileage for TH-4 in our records is 3.78 mi (as shown on the Town Highway Map... please see the mileage highlighted in the map excerpt below). However, the measure

according to our mapping software is 3.52 mi, and the measure according field inventory notes from 1989 was 3.51 mi (shown on p. 6 of Duxbury\_TH4\_Inventory\_1989.pdf, attached). The

It isn't entirely clear how this road was assigned a mileage of 3.78 mi. There is no evidence of any realignments that would explain such a large discrepancy, and the new measure is much closer to the length according to the historic Beers Atlas map from the 1870's.

Could you make sure that the Selectboard is aware of the following? I recently discovered an error (that I made) in the mileage annotation for TH-4 on the 2021 Town Highway Map. The error is only in the labels, and does not affect our mileage records, the Mileage Certificate, or the class 3 mileage totals shown in the tables on the Town Highway Map. However, as I was investigating the label discrepancy, I also noticed that the official mileage in our records for TH-4 is 3.78 miles, whereas the length according to our mapping software and a field inventory from 1989 is 3.52 miles and 3.51 miles, respectively. Please see the inventory notes detailing the 1989 remeasurement (attached). Therefore, in addition to updating the mileage labels, the Mapping Section will also include a remeasurement of class 3 TH-4 from 3.78 miles to 3.52 miles on the 2022 Mileage Certificate... unless the Town has information we are unaware of indicating a more appropriate measure.
