## Driveway of 1078 Brook Road, Marshfield, Vermont

(October 17, 2024)

#### Introduction:

Currently in the Marshfield Town Records the driveway of Manuel Sainz at 1078 Brook Road in Marshfield is a LT#1 (legal trail) indicating it was once TH#9. TH#9 was declassified as a town highway in 1957 and became LT#1. The purpose of this report is to provide doubt the driveway was ever TH#9 and provide proof from historical records TH#9 ran parallel with the driveway and therefore the records need to be updated both in the town and with VTrans who hold the historical records.

#### Report:

There is history regarding the location of what was TH#9 and now LT#1. VTrans historic maps, as provided by the Town of Marshfield, currently show the location of Legal Trail #1 as the Driveway for 1078 Brook Road. Working with VTrans I was able to review the historic maps and prepare this report. Also, VTrans provided me with Map#5 which is a Lidar Hillshade map which clearly shows a roadbed that was parallel to the driveway. VTrans believes this roadbed was in fact the old TH#9.

The following is a discussion of the evidence found.

## Evidence of the history of TH#8:

## 1. Measured distances on historic maps of TH#9

a. Historic Maps indicated that TH#9 is exactly 1.0 mile from the start of TH#8, on the Marshfield side. Both the Magenta color line in Map#5 and what is labeled as "Field Road" in Map#9 is equal to 1.0 mile. The Driveway of 1078 Brook Road is 1.05 miles from the start of TH#9. The difference of 0.05 miles is with width of the field. The Driveway does not match the historic maps for distance and therefore cannot be the old TH#9.

### 2. Length of TH#9

a. The historic maps indicated that TH#9 was 0.6 miles in length. The Driveway to the residence is only 0.25 miles, extending that out to the town line it measures 0.4 miles. Magenta line in Map#5 and Field Road in Map#9 on the other hand more closely match 0.6 miles. The Driveway of 1078 Brook Road is not close to the required length of 0.6 miles in the historic maps and therefore was NOT TH#9.

#### 3. Pattern of Magenta Line in Map #5 vs. TH#9 in Map#3

a. Look at how well the roadbed shown on Map #5 matches the actual TH#9 in Map#3. The yellow line on Map #5 is the driveway with an extension extrapolated beyond it. The yellow line is currently where VTrans has TH#9 and LT#1 located at. The extrapolation beyond the pond (next to the dot on the map) is not even possible since that area is marshland and could not be a road. It is obvious from these maps that the Driveway IS NOT the old TH#9 and therefore should not be the current LT#1.

#### 4. Washington Electric Right of Way

a. Mr. Ickovic (a previous owner) indicated the Driveway of 1078 Brook Road was owned by the Town of Marshfield because WEC performed a survey and found the Town of Marshfield owned the driveway and therefore it was TH#9 and the Town of Marshfield provided a Right of Way to Washington Electric Coop to install power lines along the driveway. After contacting WEC it was found that 1) WEC does not do any surveys and 2) Mr. Ickovic signed the

Right of Way for WEC indicating that he owned the property including the driveway. The ROW is provided in this report as evidence and Doc. #1.

## 5. Location of TH#9 in relation to the curve in the road.

a. Looking at all the Historic Maps dating back to 1858, one can see a road (most likely TH#9 since there are no other roads) starts prior to the curve in the road. The entrance to the Driveway is at the start of the curve and therefore was not the original road or TH#9.

#### 6. Location of TH#9 in relation to the sawmill

a. The old sawmill was perpendicular to the old road (TH#9). This is consistent to the Magenta line in Map#5 and Map#9.


#### Conclusion:


I have provided sufficient evidence the Driveway for 1078 Brook Road does not match the details of what was TH#9. The conclusion should now be obvious. I would like the Town of Marshfield Selectboard to review this and make a final determination of the true location of TH#9 so the town records and VTrans can update the historic maps.



MAP #5 Lidar Hillshade (by VTrans)




