ORDER OF RECLASSIFICATION

NOW COME the Selectmen of the Town of Northfield, Vermont, pursuant to 19 V.S.A. 771:

WHEREAS, pursuant to 19 V.S.A. 708(a), the Selectmen initiated proceedings to consider the reclassification of the following Town Highways:

T.H. #52 - Colson Road
T.H. #10 - Clausen/Register Road
T.H. #64 - Murphy Road
T.H. #44 - Shaneburger Road
T.H. #45 - Barrows Road
T.H. #76 - Hoffman Road

WHEREAS, the Selectmen appointed a public hearing for this purpose to be held on November 22, 1993 at 7:00PM at the Municipal Building, 26 South Main Street, Northfield, Vermont, to consider this reclassification and gave due notice thereof as required by 19 V.S.A. 709;

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing was given as follows:

- (a) On October 21, 1993, notice in the form annexed as Exhibit A was given by certified mail, postage prepaid, to those persons listed on Exhibit B, being the only persons owning or interested in lands abutting Colson Road, Clausen/Register Road, Murphy Road, Shaneburger Road, Barrows Road, Hoffman Road;
- (b) On October 21, 1993, notice in the form annexed as Exhibit C was hand delivered to the Joint Planning Commission of the Town & Village of Northfield;
- (c) On October 21, 1993, notice in the form annexed as Exhibit D was posted in the office of the Town Clerk in the Municipal Building; and

- (d) On November 4, 1993, notice in the form annexed as Exhibit E was published in the Northfield News, a paper of general circulation in the Village and Town of Northfield; and

WHEREAS, the scheduled public hearing and site inspection have concluded and the Selectmen having determined that the public good, necessity, and the convenience of the inhabitants of the municipality so require;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. To reclassify the following Town Highways from Class 4 to Class 3 pursuant to 19 V.S.A. 771:

T.H. #52 - Colson Road - being 42/100 long by 50' wide starting at the intersection of T.H. #101 (Hutchinson) thence running northerly to the end at Cassavants.

T.H. #10 - Clausen/Register Road - being 13/100 long by 33' wide starting at the end of the Class 3 section of T.H. #10 thence running easterly to the end.

T.H. #64 - Murphy Road - being 20/100 long by 50' wide starting at the intersection of T.H. #63 thence running easterly to the end of Murphy's.

T.H. #44 - Shaneburger Road - being 30/100 long by 50' wide starting at the intersection of T.H. #43 thence running easterly to the end.

T.H. #45 - Barrows Road - being 50/100 long by 50' wide starting at the end of the Class 3 section thence continuing easterly to the Hatch driveway.

T.H. #76 - Hoffman Road - 3/100 long by 50' wide starting at the end of the Class 3 section of T.H. #76 thence running easterly to the end.

2. No person or property owner having sustained damage by this reclassification, no damages shall be paid.
3. This Order shall be recorded forthwith by the Town Clerk in the Northfield Land Records.

ORDER OF DISCONTINUANCE

NOW COME the Trustees of the Village of Northfield, Vermont, pursuant to 19 V.S.A. §771:

WHEREAS, pursuant to 19 V.S.A. §708(a), the Trustees initiated proceedings to consider the discontinuance of a portion of Maple Street as a public street;

WHEREAS, the Trustees appointed a public hearing for this purpose to be held on November 23, 1993, at 7:00 o'clock p.m. at the Municipal Building, 26 South Main Street, Northfield, Vermont, to consider this discontinuance and gave due notice thereof as required by 19 V.S.A. §709;

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing was given as follows:

- (a) On October 21, 1993, notice in the form annexed as Exhibit A was given by certified mail, postage prepaid, to those persons listed on Exhibit B, being the only person owning or interested in lands abutting Maple Street.
- (b) On October 21, 1993, notice in the form annexed as Exhibit C was hand delivered to the Joint Planning Commission of the Town and Village of Northfield.
- (c) On October 21, 1993, notice in the form annexed as Exhibit D was posted in the office of the Town Clerk in said Municipal Building; and

(d) On November 4, 1993, notice in the form annexed as Exhibit E was published in the Northfield News, a paper of general circulation in the Village and Town of Northfield; and

WHEREAS, the scheduled public hearing and site inspection having concluded and the Trustees having determined that the public good, necessity, and the convenience of the inhabitants of the municipality so require;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. That all of Maple Street is hereby discontinued as a public street along it's entire length starting at the intersection of Cross Street and thence running Easterly approximately 133' to the end also being 33' wide, water lines, sewer line, and drainage lines, and all electric power lines are reserved and shall remain unimpaired by this discontinuance, and further, EXCEPT that the Village shall retain the right to drain and flow surface water drainage from Cross Street and adjacent sidewalks and related drainage facilities onto the area formerly occupied by Maple Street and thence onto adjoining properties.
2. The discontinued Street shall not be designated as a trail pursuant to 19 V.S.A. §775.

3. No person or property owner having sustained damage by this discontinuance, no damage shall be paid.
4. This Order shall be recorded forthwith by the Town Clerk in the Northfield Land Records.
