- Ben Rose came in asking for a Plainfield Rep. to the OVSWD. He also asked that we pay our FY94 "dues" in July. Then he explained the Recycling center and its possibly expendible nature. Ben will get some numbers together to see (over the next couple months) if the site warrants staying open. He also talked about some housekeeping issues.
- Rose came in with ^(sludge) sewage disposal issues and some of the options they are looking at. Brent then reviewed the contracts w/ Goddard (Water & Sewer) and its impact on the capacity (on paper). Rose told us about possible purchasing the land around some springs (8 acres) up on Maple Hill in Marshfield. The land would serve as a buffer ~~or~~ or protection area surrounding the springs.
- ~~Boris~~ Boris came in to complain about his culvert washing out. He thinks its the Town's responsibility and we'll check it out.
- We discussed the road upgrade to D. Dorfman's property. He's ready to build and wants to take the Town up on our (Hilland's) estimate.
- Gary Graves came to discuss the radio dispatch, which system go with. He wants to know our feeling. We feel that its too risky joining the cooperation. Gary agrees.
