SUBJECT: Reselection in the Town of Athens

Attached for your approval is the reselection and map for the Town of Athens.

The Selectmen, as shown on the attached letter to Mr. Munn, have refused to sign this selection because former State Aid No. 1, which has been reselected as State Aid No. 2, has been terminated at its northerly junction with Town Highway 14, and they feel that it should be extended at least as far as the southerly junction with Town Highway 14, or another 1.70 miles.

Traffic volume between the two junctions is 20 cars a day, and the rating for the northerly end, which it is proposed to retain as State Aid, has a rating of only 47 with a 70 car per day traffic volume.

The District Engineer recommends the selection as submitted, even though it would leave a dead-end State Aid Highway, because Athens is a small town and has at least made an attempt to help pave Route 35, and should receive some consideration.

We recommend that the selection be approved as submitted.
